Joseph Barnard - and Last of all I Leave my Two friends
Joseph Bell Senr and Joseph Bell Junr my only Executors

In the Name of God Amen The Twelfth day of May in the Year of our
Lord 1773 I Solomon Ashbee in the County of Cumberland being
very Sick and weak in body but of Perfect mind and memory thanks
be to God, therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my body and
that it is appointed for all Men once to die do make and Ordain this
my last will and Testament that is to say, First of all I recom-
mend my soul into the Hands of God that gave it and my body
I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner
at the Discretion of my Executors Nothing Doubting but at
the Generall Resurrection I shall receive the same again by
the Mighty Power of God, and as Touching such Worldly
Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life
I Give devise and bequeath in manner and form following -
I Give and Bequeath to Elizabeth my Dear beloved Wife
one young Mare a large Pewter Dish one Pipe Jewelling and all
the Money by me and the one third of all my Lands Stocks &
Furniture and also the Old Black Horse for Plantation use
and all the Come Puke for the House Use for Work People and the
Children that young.

I Give to my well beloved son Abel the Plantation wherewith
now live and to part and my son Eleazar of Schooner Profits to
repay the Expences of the building of the New House and one
called Hadach,

I Give and Bequeath to my well beloved son Solomon a
piece of Land containing 230 acres on the west side of the Island
amongst a Piece on Spencer Point containing 50 acres more
or less and one bed called by the Name of Asour bed;

I Give to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth one Feather bed that she
has got at Home

I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth one bed called by the Name of
Old Jonathan bed at her Mothers Decease

I Give to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Chaplain one Feather bed
called after Mothers Bedsteads Whence one God being
and all the Sheep I Give in Her Marke and their Increase

I Give to my son in law William Chaplain one Shilling
I Give to my beloved Wife the small Boat for Northfildene
and at Her Decease to my two Daughters Elizabeth & Elizabeth

and what I give to my Daughter Eliz my wife to keep in her hands till the Girl comes of age but if my Wife should die I appoint my Son Abel and the Mayo he was in the House to Buy the little boat a sail

Item I give and bequeath all my Stocks and furniture to be Equally Divided amongst my Four Children in a full Solomon Hezekiah and Elizabeth and my Sons and Daughters Herish to take three Parts at three run some of the Stock and Furniture

Item I appoint my Son Abel my sole Executor and one bed To be to my Wife

Item my will is that a Parcel of Land Lying on or in the former Swamp which contains one hundred and thirty acres and more should be sold to raise Money to satisfy my Brother Joseph's Debt due from me to him the same to be sold at Public Sale.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving Wife Ann Mason nine eighths and her share in the and the third of my Estate to wit then and an

Item further my Will is that after my Death is settled and paid that the remainder of my Estate which is left shall be Equally Divided amongst and between my Daughter Sedney Mason and James Mason and Sarah Mason.

And I also appoint Solomon Fishbee and James Fishbee sole Executors to this my Will allowing this to be my last Will and Testament in Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 25th Day of November in one thousand seven hundred and seventy three
