A Noncaptive will of Samuel Whitehurst, dec'd, made in his last sickness, in his own house, as follows. November the 24th 1814.

Item. It is my will that my wife Frances Whitehurst, shall have half my gang of shined hogs, to her and her heirs forever.

Item. It is my will that my son Gideon Whitehurst, and my son Samuel Whitehurst shall have my hand mill, that is an Indian ridge at Gideon Whitehurst's, to them and their heirs forever.

Item. It is my will that my son Enoch Whitehurst and my son Peter Whitehurst shall have my hand mill, that is a frame an east ridge, to them and their heirs forever.

I Benjamin Russell of the county of Currituck and State of North Carolina being weak in body, but of a sound disposing mind and memory, calling to mind, that it is appointed to all men to die, do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament in manner, and form as follows. First recommending my soul to almighty God that gave it to me

Item. I lend unto my wife the house and plantation, whereon I live, during her natural life or widowhood, and one negro woman named Sallies, and one boy, Sam, are girl Grace during her natural life or widowhood, on his keeping her, two children, Susannah, and Daniel Russell, of six of my expense to keep.

Item. I give to my wife one negro man called, two feather beds and furniture, and all the iron-ware and chairs and chests and table, to her, and her heirs. I also lend unto my wife after selling enough to pay my just debts all of my indebted property during her widowhood. Item. I give unto my son Daniel Russell the plantation whereon I now live and one boy by the name of George, to him and his heirs.

Item. I give unto my daughter Susannah, after the death or marriage of my wife, one negro woman by the name of Sallies, one boy by the name of Sam, one girl by the name of Grace, and all the rest of my estate within doors and without, to my daughter Susannah, except the crop and hogs to go to my wife and heirs. I do nominate my brother Daniel Summers, to be my whole and sole executor to this my last will and testament, and do empower him to act as he may think best for my children. In witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal this the 27th of November, 1814.

I Solomon Jarvis of Currituck county, being of sound and perfect mind and memory, blessed be God, do this second day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, make and publish this my last will and Testament, in manner following, that is to say First, I give and bequeath to my son Doest Jarvis, one feather bed and furniture, and sundry other articles already in his possession, to him and his heirs forever. Item. I give and bequeath to my son Ephraim Jarvis one pewee, bason and sundry other articles already in his possession. Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter Isabel Hudson one feather bed and furniture and one chest of sundry other articles already in her possession, to her and her heirs forever. Item. I give and bequeath to my son Samuel Jarvis, two dollars to be raised out of my estate, to him and his heirs forever. Item. My will is that my two last sons John Jarvis and William Jarvis shall have all my land, if they live to the twenty one years of age, and if either of them dies before he is twenty one years

of age, my will is that the other should have all the land, and if they both die before they are twenty one years of age, I then give the said land to my son Lovell Jarvis and his heirs forever. I then I bind the use of my plantation and stock, and all my estate after paying my debts to my wife Sarah Jarvis during her widowhood, and at her intermarriage or death my will is that all my estate except my land shall be equally divided between my two daughters Zephia Jarvis and Eliza Jarvis, to them and their heirs forever. My will is that my executors should sell eight acres of my land near to Samuell Whitehead to said S. Whitehead at a price stated. And I hereby ordain and appoint my son Lovell Jarvis and Mr. Samuel Dury son my executors to this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I the said Solomon Jarvis have to this my last will and Testament, set my hand and seal the day and year above written

I Jeremiah Mercer son of the county of Currituck, being of sound and perfect mind and memory, do hereby on the 11th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner following. I give and bequeath to my son Jeremiah Mercer one silver dollar, to be raised out of my estate to him and his heirs forever. I then I bind to my daughter Mary Mercer during her life a certain piece of land, bounded as follows, beginning at a pine stump so, thence by Anthony Simmons corner, running north westerly to a large position tree in the plantation, and so on straight to a ditch, and thence with said ditch 3/4 eastwardly to an other ditch, thence easterly straight to the first station, for her to live on during her widowhood, and at her death, I give the same to William G. Mercer, and his heirs forever. I then I give and bequeath to my son William G. Mercer, all my land that lyeth north of the string of Juniper rails fence, straight each way, to the Juniper fence now stands to him and his heirs forever, which will cover the land I lent M. Mercer. I then I give and bequeath to my son bounding Mercer, all my land, lying on the south

side of the Juniper fence, which I bounded W. G. Mercer, which will cover the buildings whereon I now live to him and his heirs forever, also I give to said bounding Mercer one negro woman named Comfort and one negro woman named Peg, and one negro boy named Portia and one negro girl Esty, together with all the rest of my property, within doors and without, after paying my just debts to him and his heirs forever. And I hereby make and ordain my friend Mr. Simmons executor of this my last will and Testament, to be the said bounding Mercer, son, have to this my last will and Testament, set my hand and seal the day and year above written
