calling to mind the uncertainty of human life and that it is appointed for
all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and
Testament in manner and form following.

I Give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Kallam one half
of my land and plantation bearing John Adams land and a growing
named Sarah one young black horse one cow one yearling and one
heifer bred to him and his heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Poole one negro
girl named Ruth and one negro girl named Betsy one cow and lamb
one young bay mare and one yearling old Colt to be his forever.

I Give and bequeath to my sons Stephens Kallam and Frederick
Kallam one negro boy named Peter and one negro girl named Mary
the negro girl named Peg to be equally divided between them and
their heirs and to each of them one father bed and of either of
them his his lawfully begotten of his body to give to the other to the end
and their heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath to my daughter Fanny Kallam one negro
Man named Sam and one filly and to keep his heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath to my son William Kallam one half
of my land and plantation bearing Andrew Dickens land to him
and his heirs forever it is my will and desire that my son Benjamin
Kallam shall have the care of the land and plantation bequeathed
to my son William till he is fifteen years of age to keep him
sound him and school him and if either of my two sons Benjamin
and William die without his lawfully begotten of their bodies to give to
the other and his heirs forever it is my will and desire that one of
the horse one old mare the hog and wild have some place my share
Remainder of sheep stay on the plantation for the care of my children and
plantation and all now growing.

I Give and bequeath all the rest and under of my movable property
after my debts is paid to be equally divided between my two sons
Stephens and Frederick and their heirs forever. Lastly I will and desire
that my son Benjamin Kallam and Frederick Kallam be and are hereby
appointed my Executor to this my last will and Testament Given under
my hand and Seal this 14th day of July 1804.
