Daughters Mary Fenton Elizabeth Fenton Sarah Fenton
and my well Beloved Wife Rhoda Fenton
With William Rhodes my sole Executor of this my Last Will
and Testament by which I Release and Disannull all former
Wills and Testaments by me made before herefore made
Whereof I have Minors and my Executors and Executors of my
and Executors Administration.
