Item my will and desire is that my beloved wife have the use of all my perishable
Estate and land my son John not to be disturbed when he now lives during
her natural life or her widowhood but not to make master of any of the said Estate
willingly. If my Executors hereafter mentioned should see or discover that
my wife Mary Thomson should be making sale of any of my Estate lands
to anybody it or to keep the same from any of my children at her death
or marriage then for my Executors to take the Estate in their hands and
bestow it in the manner and form following which is my will that after
my wife Marys decease or death that my perishable Estate be equally divided

Between Elisabeth Thomson, Mary Thomson, Malachi Thomson, Thomas Thomson, Martha Thomson, Mary Thomson, Susan Thomson, John Thomson, my children to them and their heirs forever. I leave my son John Thomson
