can be found within doors and without in
case he the said Samuel Whitehurst should die
without Lawful issue of his body then
in that Case My desire is that my said Estate
should goe unto my Sister Rebecca Nicholson
and her heirs for ever
And I do appoint my trusty friend Edward Leigh
my whole and sole Executor in whatsoever
I have hereunto set my hand this 27th day
of July 1795

Barroly Point Currituck County and Province of
North Carolina being of perfect Mind Memory
blessed by God for it and Calling to mind the frailty
of Nature with the shortness of life and certainty of
Death do make and ordain this my last Will and
Testament (Viz) I send to my Wife the during
her life one half of any Elevation I know live
one good bed and furniture I send her one cow
and calf during her life and one oat table I send
her one blue Chest during her life I likewise send
unto her all my hogs I send to her during her life
two wheels and one box of Ditties and pots and all my
Cutlery and likewise one looking Glass and four Chairs
likewise I send her one loom and harness and my axe
and hoes I give to her one bee hive I give unto my
Brother John M. Cog my horse and half the corn
and I give him the Noll of hand against Edward Barker
it being for eight Barrels of Corn and two bee hives
and one Cog I likewise give him one trunk and all
the empty Barrels and four Chair frames and hand
Mill one Table I give to my two Sisters each three
Counds apiece hatters I appoint my Brother John
M^r Cog Executor of this my last Will and Testament
whomof I hereto set my hand and seal this twenty
eight Day of June one thousand seven hundred
and Ninety five.
