First, I give unto my beloved Wife Julian one Cow & Darling one Leather Dress Furniture a new Blue Coat one white Linen Coat and all my Plate and one half of all my Land and one Barrel of Good African Ware Marble Chills with husband live this for ever.

And for the remainder of my Estate I desire to be paid for six Months credit when the Money is to be equally divided between Thomas Holt & John McLanney of my Coors

to them & their heirs forever after paying my just debts And I do hereby constitute and appoint my loving friend John McLanney & Josiah Nicholson my Executors to be my Executors in which I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this eleventh day of January 1798

In the Name of God Amen I James Mahab of the County of Currituck & State of North Carolina being weak of Body but of sound disposing mind & of a more happy than common hope for it calling to mind the more certainty of this Life yet being ordained gods for all People to die I do make & ordain this Testament of Writing to contain my last Will & Testament disannulling & taking all other Wills & Testaments before made by me either by word or writing & that only to be taken as my last Will & Testament first that is to say I recommend my soul to Almighty God that gave it and my body to be decently in a Christian way & manner buried in a place where I shall please my Executors hereafter named for to what worldly Estate it hath been please God to settle me far above my deserts I give & dispose in manner & form as followeth first my Will & desire is that all my just debts & general charges should be first paid in convenient time after my decease my Will & desire is that my loving Wife Rachel should have one hundred & fifty acres of land to be taken of off the East end of my estate including of my Plantations & all the improvement thereunto belonging to her and her Heirs for ever.

Item I give unto my daughter in Law Little Joe fifty acres of land & joining her Mother to her & her Heirs for ever. Item I give unto my respected friend Elias Garrison fifty acres of land joining Little Joe to her & her Heirs for ever. Item I give unto my beloved Cousin Allen Burrows fifty acres of land joining Little Joe to her and her Heirs for ever.
