

In the name of God Amen, Thomas Robb of the County of Currituck & State of North Carolina, being weak of body but of sound disposing mind & memory blessed be the Almighty God for it, calling to mind the more certainties of this life, & being convinced once for all people to die, do make & ordain this Instrument of writing to contain my Last Will & Testament, disannulling & revoking all other Wills & Testaments by me made by me either by word or writing, & this only to be taken as my last Will & Testament, first that is to say, I commend my soul to Almighty God that gave it & my body to be decently in a Christian like manner buried in a place where it should please my Executors hereafter named & as to what worldly Estate I have been pleased God to bestow upon me above my deserts, I give & dispose in manner & form as followeth, first my Will & desire is that all my Just debts & pecuniary charges should be first paid in convenient time after my decease, my will & desire is that my loving wife Mary should have the use of half of all my Lands during her life & after her decease I give the sd. land to my eldest Son Jacob to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give half of my moveable Estate after all my Lawfull debts charged is paid to my loving wife at her disposal at her decease, Item I give to my eldest Son Jacob all the remain of my lands to him & his heirs forever, I also give to my eldest Son Jacob the remainder of my moveable Estate to him & his heirs forever, He constitute & appoint my loving wife Mary & my second Son George Robb my whole sole Executors to this my Last Will & Testament to settle all my business according to this my last will & Testament & the Law shall require & without my hand & seal this 24th day of September in the year of our Lord 1783.

my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with I dispose of in manner as follows after paying all my debts & my Creditors satisfied I give unto my dear & beloved wife Ruth Ann Clark all my moveable Estate likewise the one third of my lands during as my wife live, I give unto my son Henry Clark all my lands to him & his heirs forever I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Clark one main Colt to her & her heirs forever.

I also appoint my well beloved wife Ruth Ann Clark & my son Henry Clark sole & sole Executors & Administrators of this & no other to be my last Will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day & year above mentioned.

Item I give to my daughter Celia Pugh one leather Bed two Cows & calves & two Mares the rest of my moveable Estate with a Negroe French Watchet to my beloved wife Hannah Pugh & she may make & assign George Pugh & Hannah Pugh Executors of this my last Will & Testament, In witness whereof I the said Thomas Pugh have to this my last Will & Testament set my hand & seal the day & year above written.
