July Anno Domini 1763.

Present his Honorable Justices.

The last Will & Testament having been here before Shown in due form
the Executor thereof duly qualified was ordered to be acquainted with
accordingly follows in these words To wit

In the Name of God Amen

I John Cooper of Currituck County Planter and in flesh married & of
sound Mind being in good health and of sound Mind Perfect Memory I do hereby
be to almighty God for ill and now Calling to mind Transferring
and Resolving that it is appointed for all Mankind to Die & that
for my worldly goods whereof I will has Pleased almighty God to Bless
me with I Do Declare In this manner as Follows

Item I give & bequeath to my Son John Cooper one young Cow to be Called a Cow
Bullworth & a Declaration Money and that to be his full & separate Right of my
Estate to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Deborah Ferbee one young Cow to be
Called a Cow Bullworth & a Declaration Money and that to be her full
Bullworth & a Declaration Money and that to be her full & separate Right of my
Estate to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I give to my Granddaughter Ann Ferbee one young Cow to be
Called a Cow Bullworth & a Declaration Money and that to be her full

Item I give to William Ferbee one young Cow to be

and my Son in Law William Ferbee and my Son John Cooper Executors
they they to be my sole and sole Executors and Executors of this my
Last Will and Testament with all things whereof I have here written of my moveable
and Fixed my Seal this Twelfth Day of July in the year of our
Lord Christ One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Two
