In the Name of God amen I Thomas Baers of the County of Dorchester  
being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory  
thanks be given to God, calling unto mind the mortality of body knowing  
it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and declare  
this my last will and testament that is to say principally and full  
of all I Give and recommend my soul into hand to almighty  
God that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be  
buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors  
nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall live  
the same again by the mighty Power of God, and as touching  
such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me  
In this life I Give devise and dispose of the same  
In the following manner and form.

First I Give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary  
all my ready money and one negro man named Zephyr  
with all and singular the rest to my property of every sort  
during of his natural life and then to be disposed of in the following  
manner, and first of all I Give and bequeath to my well  
beloved children, Sarah, Mary, Thomas, Christian, Richard  
Benjamin, John, with any, six hundred and forty acres of  
land lying on Long Shoal river, to be equally divided  
among them, also I Give and bequeath to my daughter  
Mary one Negro woman named Edith and two boys named  
Sack and Andrew, also I Give and bequeath to my  
Grand son Benjamin Daniel one negro Girl  
named Charry, also I Give and bequeath to my son Thomas  
one negro boy named Somer, also I Give to my daughter  
Christian one negro Girl named Edith, also I Give to my  
son Rich. and Son, one Negro woman named Rachel  
also I Give to my son John one negro Girl named Willy  
also I Give to my daughter Pethany one negro woman named Gudy

Also I Give to my Grand son David Paers one negro Girl  
named Nell, also I Give to my Grand son Thomas Paers  
one negro boy named Parson, also I Give to my three sons  
Thomas, Richard, Son, John one negro man named Sef,  
also I Give to my daughter Pethany any of that piece of land wher  
the new lives begining at Jacob Mayalls line to the Great  
Tree running then East eleven degrees South to the sea  
also I Give to my son John that piece of land wher  
the new lives from the Great Juniper tree to the great live  
at the Old School house, running then East eleven degrees South  
to the sea also I Give to my Grand son George Paers  
Richard and Son, the piece of land wher he now lives from the  
Great oak at the School House to the Vain pole oak running  
then East eleven degrees South to the sea side also I Give to my  
Grand son Thomas Paers piece of land from the Barn pole  
Oak to son a dream then East eleven degrees South to the sea side  
also I Give to my son Richard and Son, a piece of land from  
the sea a dream to my North line then East to the sea side  
also I Give to my son Thomas that piece of land wher he now  
lives East aiming one hundred and fifty acres, also I Give to my  
son Thomas Richard and Son all my land on Cape Pasture to be  
equally divided among them, also I Give to my three sons Thomas  
Richard and Son all my water passages, also I Give to my  
daughter Pethany one mare white flower, also I Give to my  
Grand son Thomas Paers one mare white spray, and three  
head of Cattle and one Gun, also I Give to my children Sarah  
Mary Thomas, Christian, Richard and Son, Pethany all my  
Stock of every kind, to be divided equally among them, also I  
Give to my son Thomas, Richard, Son, John and Pethany a  
fourth part a piece, also I Give to my three sons Thomas, Richard  
and Son all and singular my property to be equally divided  
among them after I contribute of my property to my three sons Thomas, Richard  
and Son the sole executors of this my last will and testament and  
I do John the sole executor of this my last will and testament and  
I do hereby utterly disavow, revoke, annul, and give any other former  
testaments, wills, bequests, or provisions, by me in any way before  
made, called, or bequeathed, ratified, and confirming, this of no other to be  
of any force or effect, in testimony whereof I have hereunto set  
my hand and seal, this 15<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. 1793. Thomas Baers
