Hampshire & County of Carroll being sick & weak in body by reason, but of
perfect mind & memory thanks be to God, for it calling unto mind the
Mortality of men & knowing its appointed unto all men once to die & after
that to judgement do make & ordain this my last will & testament first of
all I give my Soul to the Lord, who gave it to me, & my body to be buried in
a Christian like manner by my Executors & as touching of my worldly
estate I give it in manner & form as follows.

I give & bequeath to my four Children namely Julian Capps.
Polly Capps. Josiah Capps. & Valley Capps. all of my estate to be equally
divided amongst them first selling of it & dividing the money arising
therefrom, after my lawful debts being paid by my Executors from the
principal of sale & if either of the before mentioned Children should
die under age, for any number of them for that or their
Heirs if the before mentioned estate to go to them & their Heirs, &c. &c.
I also constitute & appoint my friend & Malachi Capps my sole
Executor to this my last will & testament, in witness whereof I have signed
my Seal to be witness, & signed the above, the fourth day of October
1803, signed Sealed in the presence, of us.

In the Name of God Amen. I Thomas Pool Williams being sick in
Body & sound disposing mind & memory do make & ordain this to be my last
will & testament to say first, it is my will & desire that my Executors
& hereafter mentioned pay all my last debts. Second I give & bequeath
all my lands & plantation at Indian Town in Carroll County
to my Son Samuel Williams also one tract of Swamp Swamp
near the three Ponds, of one hundred & fifty acres that formerly
belonged to my father & finally I leave all my Negroes, to be
divided between my wife Elizabeth Williams my daughter Polly
my son Samuel, & finally I leave all my lands, not given
away to be sold at five & ten dollar months estate after my debts
are paid the residue of my estate to be divided between my wife
daughter & son before mentioned. In Testimony I have hereunto set
my hand & signed my Seal the day & date before mentioned.
