

The last Will and testament of Thomas White Decd.
Exhibited and Proved August Term 1823

In the name of God Amen, I Thomas White of the County
of Currituck and State of North Carolina being in perfect
mind and memory calling to mind the mortality of the
body that it is appointed for all men to die do make
and ordain this my last will and testament in manner
and form following:

I do lend the land and plantation whereon I now live
to my beloved wife, Sally White and also all my
moveable property and negroes during her natural life
or widowhood and at her Death or marriage I give the same
to my son Thomas White and one feather bed to him
and his heirs forever and if my son Thomas White
dies without heirs I give it to my son Armistead White
to him and his heirs forever

Also at my wife's death or marriage I give all my
moveable property to be equally divided between
my children by name Meloy White, Polly White,
Sally White and Armistead White and also all
my negroes to be equally divided to them and
their heirs forever.

I do lend my land on Piruy Island and my
land on the banks to my wife Sally White during
her natural life or widowhood and at her death
or marriage I give it to my son Armistead White
to him and his heirs forever.

And I do appoint John Larver and James Satum
the sole and sole executors to this my last
will and testament I June 16th day 1823

The Last Will and testament of Willis Knauge Decd.
Exhibited and Proved at August term 1823

In the name of God Amen I Willis Knauge of the
County of Currituck and State of North Carolina being
sick at this present and weak in body but of a sound
mind and memory do make and establish this my
last will and testament in manner and form as follows
that is to say = I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife
Chloe Knauge one bed and furniture & seven shins bone
table and bedding, which I also lend my wife Chloe
Knauge the residue of my Estate during her life or
widowhood and at her death or marriage to be
equally divided between my three Children Eliza,

Patsy and Elisa after paying my last debts I wish
my executor to sell privately as much of my property as
will pay my debts and I appoint Joel Gorey my sole
and sole executor to this my last will and testament
Revolving all other wills made by me prior to this
whereof I have set my hand and seal this 29th
day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and twenty three
