

The Last Will & Testament of Unice Walthead Decreed was exhibited & proved in open Court at August Term 1830.

I Unice Walthead of the County of Currituck and State of North Carolina do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following Viz. I give and bequeath unto my dear sister Eliza Thompson of the lands where I now live adjoining the lands of John Williams, Samuel Thompson and John Mathias I also give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my Estate goods, Chattels moving appan all &c to my dear beloved sister Eliza Thompson whom I nominate, constitute and appoint sole executrix of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all other and former wills by me at any time heretofore made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, the thirty first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight and thirty nine.

This Last Will and Testament of Henry Evans was exhibited & proved in open Court at May Term 1830.

In the name of God Amen I Henry Evans of Currituck County and State of North Carolina being weak in body but sound in mind and in my perfect senses calling to mind that it is appointed for all men to die do make and establish this my last will and Testament in manner as follows first I give and bequeath unto my son Jesse Evans my young horse to him and his heirs forever.

- 2^d Item I give unto my wife Edney Evans all of my property land or what come ever of every kind without doer and within living of her natural life or Widowhood.
- 3^d Item I give and bequeath unto my son Jesse Evans my mare after my wifes death or marriage unto him & his heirs forever. Now if my mare should bring the foal she is with that she comes with foal ~~she~~ it is my will and desire that my son Jesse Evans should take his choice of the two and the other I give to my son James Evans and his heirs forever.
- 4th Item I give & bequeath unto my son Jesse Evans six Minsor Shirts after my wifes death or marriage unto him & his heirs forever.
- 5th Item It is my will & desire that the bee I bea ~~bea~~ that was given to my son Jesse by his Grandfather that he shall take it in possession immediately after my death.
- 6th Item It is my will & desire that the Sifter that my father gave to my daughter Sally that she should take it in possession immediately after my death.
- 7th Item I give & bequeath to my son James Evans One feather Bed and One Iron Pot I lent to him when he was married to him and his heirs for ever.
- 8th Item I give unto my daughter Sally one feather bedstead & furniture sayth to be kept in.
- 9th Item I give unto my daughter Abby Evans one feather bedstead & furniture the bed & and my wifes shif on one Earthen Doffer white & red colour one Spoon the big chest & my old hinnen wheel to her & her heirs for ever.
