

Alphabetical Table

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North Carolina. In the name of God, Amen, I William Bayly of the county and Province of Carolina do make and make in this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following Viz.

Item. I give to my son William Bayly a plantation at the Church joining John Lewis and Mr. Fellys lives, containing fifty-nine acres to him the said William Bayly and his heirs forever.

Item. I give to my son William Bayly the third part of my land upon Snow live, part what Joseph Rogers to him the said William Bayly and his heirs forever.

Item. I give unto my son James Bayly the plantation whereon I now live with one third part of the land I hold in the tract to him the said James Bayly and his heirs forever. Furthermore if the child my wife is now big with should be a male I give the other third part of the land I now live on, unto the same child and his heirs forever and if the said child should die without issue or be a female I give the one half of said land to my son William Bayly and his heirs forever the other half to son James Bayly and his heirs forever.

Item. I give unto my daughter Sarah Bayly negro boy, James to her and her heirs forever. I give to my daughter Elizabeth Bayly the five child negroes which she shall bring to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I give the rest of my estate to my wife Mary Bayly during her life, only if she should marry she shall have no charge or care of the same and use my children ill, but if it is the pleasure of the court to praise and divide the same between my children and my wife with the same, and if the child my wife is now big with should be a female I give to her a negro boy which she shall choose. And I desire and appoint my wife Mary Bayly and son William Bayly and Colonel John Woodhouse my executor and Executors of this my last will and Testament.
