 bequeath to my Daughter Ann one Shilling Sterling.
 Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Roger one Shilling
 Sterling. Item I Give and bequeath to my Son William
 one Shilling Sterling. Item I Give and bequeath to
 my well beloved Wife Elizabeth Michens all the
 Remaining Part of my Estate During her Widowhood.
 And at the End of her Life to be Legally Divided between
 my Sons John Caled Michens Thos. Michens John
 Michens and Moses Michens.
 Item I Give and bequeath to my Son John Caled Richard
 John & Moses to have and their Heirs Lawfully
 begotten of their Bodies forever. Item I Give and
 bequeath to my Son Caled one Deshpone feather
 bed and Furniture.

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Richard one feather bed &
 Furniture and two Quens one which was my own Shilling
 Rice and the Other the Quen formerly sent my son
 Jacob. Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter
 Ann one feather bed. Item I Give and bequeath to my
 Son John one feather bed. Item I Give and bequeath
 all my moveable Estate to be Equally Divided between
 my Five Youngest Children. Item I Recommend
 appoint my well beloved Wife Elizabeth Michens
 and my son William Michens Executors of my
 Last Will and Testament in Testimony whereof I
 have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this Twentieth
 third Day of December 1771.
