 & Nine pigs & all one feather Bed to her & her heirs forever
 I Give unto my son James Burnham one Cow & three Pigs
 to him and his heirs for ever — I Give ^{to} my son Samuel
 Burnham one Cow & five pigs to him & his heirs for ever
 And after my Just Debts are paid the Remainder of my Estate
 to be Equally Divided betwixt my wife & three children
 hereby annulling all other Wills by me Made Acknowledging
 this to be my Last Will & Testament & hereby appointing
 my beloved wife to be my whole & sole Exor. in Writings
 whereof I have unto I have set my hand & seal this
 Twelveth day of Feb. 1798

 unto Vastle James Daughter of Lucia James a Child
 Being Sworn to me two shillings to be paid out of
 my Estate to her and her heirs for ever I Give & bequeath
 unto my beloved wife Mary Robinson all my
 Lands and Estate that I now Possess During her Natural

Life and after her Decease my Will and Desire is that
 the Estate at her Decease be Equally Divided between my
 Sons and I Do Constitute and appoint my son Charles
 Robinson Jonathan and Tully Robinson and Mantoff
 Robinson my sole Executor to this my Last Will and
 Testament in Writings whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand & fixed my Seal this 14th Day of October 1798
