 all men once to dy (so make and ordaine this my last
 will and testament in manner and form as follow, and
 first of all I give to my beloved wife Sally Lee all the lands
 I possess to her and her heirs forever. I also give to my
 well beloved wife, as above mentioned all the rest of of my
 property within doors & without to her and her heirs forever
 Whereunto I set my hand & seal this 10th day of January 1822

The last will and Testament of Willoughby
Basnett Exhibited and proved at May Term 1822

Be it Remembered, That I Willoughby Basnett of
 Cape Hatteras Banks in the County of Currituck and
 State of N.C. being very sick and weak in body
 though in perfect mind and memory than has begun
 to Almighty God, calling to mind the mortality of
 the body and knowing it is appointed for all men
 once to die - do make and ordain this my last will
 and testament Viz Principally and first of all, I give
 and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God
 who gave it nothing doubting that after the general
 Resurrection But I shall receive the same again
 My Body I give and recommend to the earth to be
 buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion
 of my Executors & as touching such worldly estate
 as God hath been pleased to bless me with in this life
 I give and dispose of in the following manner

That is to say, Principally and first of all I give and
 bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Basnett my
 dwelling house & fifty acres of Land on which it stands
 together with all my but houses premises and ornaments
 of every description then and there to have full and
 quiet possession of the same until my daughter Polly L
 Basnett shall arrive at the mature age of twenty one years
 and then it is my wish that my beloved wife Mary
 Basnett shall still have full possession of my dwelling house
 during her widowhood and in case of my wife's marriage
 then it is my wish that my daughter Polly L Basnett may
 have full possession of all my dwellings, then it is my request
 that my beloved wife Mary Basnett shall have from my stock
 of cattle four head, one Brind Cow & yearling & two
 sheaves now bearing the stock mark of my father Robert
 Basnett dec'd Three head of cattle I give and bequeath unto my
 Daughter Polly L Basnett viz one dark brind cow and yearling
 and one Pide heifer being in the stock mark of my father, also
 I give unto my wife Mary Basnett one Bed and furniture
 the bedstead being ash, this together with one sorrel horse
 with bridle and saddle, to my daughter Polly L Basnett
 to my daughter Polly L Basnett I give and bequeath
 one Bed & furniture with my old red mare & yearling also
 with one young mare with a blaze face I send unto my
 daughter Sabra Williams Sixty three & one third acres of Land
 whereon she now lives this after her death to
 her heirs forever, one Black cow and yearling together
 with one feather head & furniture belonging to it
 This with five head of ewe sheep one Bay mare
 I request to be sold together with all such property
 as my executors may think unbeneficial to my wife
 and daughter and that all my just debts may be
 paid out of such money and the surplus if any is to be
 laid out in necessary in order to support my wife
 and daughter. It is my request that the remains
 of my stock together with all my moveable
 property both in doors and out doors to be equally

divided between my wife and Daughter at my Daughters arrival at the age of twenty one year - I also constitute make ordain and appoint my true and worthy friends Wallace Hyron & Lacey Dinnick my Executors to this my last will and testament and do hereby disavow revoke and disnull all and every other Testament legacies Bequeath Executors by me in any way named willed and bequeaths Matting and confirming these same no other to be my last will and testament. In witness where of I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the eighth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two - Sealed signed and put in the presence of us witnesses

The last will and testament of Daniel Sanderson Exhibited and proved at term 1822

State of Maryland In the name of God Amen -
Baltimore County } I Daniel Sanderson Planter of the County aforesaid make and constitute this to be my last will and testament. First of all I recommend my immortal Soul into the hands of all mighty God that gave it and as for my worldly goods I lend and give in the following manner. Nam. I give the whole of my Land to be equally divided between my four Sons John James Thomas and Tyse Sanderson.

Nam. I lend to my wife Nigrowes Rachel and Charles and Pingo (During her life or widowhood and after his death or marriage I give the above named Nigrowes to be equally divided between my four sons John James Thomas Tyse

Nam. I give to my wife her choice of six cows

and calves out of my stock and the remainder to be sold for six months credit and divided ^{equally} between all of my children Nam. I give to my wife all of my sheep also I give her all of my hogs except them on the bank which is to be sold and the money to be equally divided between all of my children

Nam. I give to my wife the horse named Prince and mare named Philis and my riding chair and lamp also all of my corn except twenty bbl which is to be sold and divided between all of my children also I

I give all of my proke and Bacon to my Wife except one thousand wale which is to be sold and divided between all of my children, also I

give to my wife all the land except the large lot which is to be sold and equally divided between all of my children, also I give to my

wife all of my farming tools, also I give to my wife all of my house hold and kitchen furniture, also I give to my wife my steers, cart

Nam. I give to my daughter Polly a Negro man by the name of Whittle and one Nigrow girl named Lydia

Nam. My will and desire is that my Nigrow Sarah and her increase be equally divided between all of my children

Nam. I give my two Nigrow Boys Luke and March to be equally divided between my four sons John James Thomas Tyse Sanderson

Nam. My two young Horses to be sold and the money to be equally divided between all of my children also my third of ochroner lively to be sold and equally divided between all of my children and my canoe I give to my wife and all the property belonging to me that is not mentioned in this my will to be sold and equally divided between all of my children.

Nam My will and desire is in this my last will that my wife be in full possession of all my land during ^{her} life or widowhood provided she keep her children clear of charge also I give all
