Chilton one negro woman named Cuthbert
and her increase from this day also one
negro boy named Miles also one feather
bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath to my son Peter
Chilton one negro girl and her increase
named Blassey also one negro Boy named
March & one negro Boy named Harry
also one negro girl named Nancy
and one negro boy named Peter and
one feather bed and furniture to him
and his heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath to my son in law
William Lamb one Dollar to him and his
heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath to my Grand
sons that is to say brothers Lamb William Lamb
Enoch Lamb & John Lamb & Peter Lamb sons
of William Lamb one Dollar a piece to be raised
out of my estate to each of them and their heirs forever
Item I have all the rest of my property within
doors and without doors after paying my
last debts and funeral charges to be equally
divided between my sons John Chilton and
Peter Chilton to them and their heirs forever
Lastly I nominate Constitute and appoint my
son John Chilton my sole and sole executor
to this my last will and Testament in
writing whereof the said my self Chilton have
hereunto set my hand seal the day & date above
written. Sealed & Acknowledgment of
my Testimony. And for me in great Mind
Exhibited White Sph. Boston was Clerk

The Last will and Testament of

our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and eighteen make and Publish this my
last will and Testament in manner
following that is to say
First I give and bequeath to my wife
Hester Brown after my decease all my
Property that I have after paying all my
last Debts during her natural life
and after her death to Benjamin Daugh-
ter forth and if he should die without a
heir give him it is my will and desire
that Miles & Patridge should be the same
for him and his heirs forever and I hereby
make and ordain my beloved wife
Hester Brown Executrix to the my last
will and Testament in writing whereof
I the said Luke Brown have to this
my last will and testament set my
hand and seal the day and year
above written sealed & Acknowledged
Declared by the said Luke Brown
the Testator as his last will and Testament
in presence of us
