I William Austin being sick but of perfect sound mind thanks be to
giving to God do make this my last will and Testament in following
manner and form viz. do make this my last will and Testament in
manner following that is to say I give to all my lawful heirs one
dollar a piece then I give to my daughter Mary hiselle all my estate
subsisting of one gun that I give to my grown son Garrison
and I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend Joel Capps
Executor of my last will and Testament in writing whereof I the
said William Austin have to this my last will and Testament set
my hand and seal this twenty third of December 1823
Signed Sealed and published and delivered by the said William Austin

making and signing hereof

The Last Will And Testament of William Anderson
Exhibited and proved February Term 1824.

In the name of God Amen
I William Anderson of the County of Currituck and State of
North Carolina being now in my Seventy seventh year of age and in
reasonable health do make this my last will and Testament
I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Perkins one dollar which
with what she has already received from me to be her part
of my estate I give unto my grandson William Perkins one
cow and gearlin being the same his mother has had the
use of this year I give unto my granddaughter Polly Perkins
one cow and lamb I give unto my daughter Polly Anderson
one bedstead and furniture one walnut chest one linen Wheel
one womans saddle and one beaput I give unto my two sons
William and Benjamin all the remainder of my estate to be
equally divided between them and they my two sons to support
their mother as long as she lives lastly I nominate and appoint
my two sons William and Benjamin Executors to this my last
will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
seal this 6th day of September 1819.

The Last Will and Testament of John Dofy
Exhibited and proved in Court February Term 1824.

In the name of God Amen.
I John Dofy of the County of Currituck and State of North Carolina being
in common health at this time present and of a disposing mind
and memory and knowing the uncertainty of this life am minded
to make this my last will and Testament in the following manner
I promise I have the use and benefit of all my land and plantation
together with all my personal estate after my death to the only
love of my beloved wife Mary Dofy during her widowhood and to
be disposed of in the following manner hereafter mentioned.
I give and bequeath unto my son Sampson Dofy all the land and
premises whereon I now live after the widowhood of my wife Mary
and the piece of Swamp land called the Kilger land or swamp to
him and his heirs forever
I give and bequeath unto James Dofy my son one feather bed
and furniture after the decease of my wife Mary and no more of
my estate whatever
I give to the heirs of John Dofy dead and to the heirs of Sophia
Gray wife of Henry Gray one dollar each out of my personal
estate after the death of my wife Mary that is one dollar to
John Dofys heirs & one to Sophia Grays heirs
I give unto my son Sampson Dofy after the death of my wife
Mary one dollar for his part of my personal estate and no more
I give and bequeath unto Sanford Dofy William Dofy my
two sons the two thirds of my piece of juniper swamp adjoining
Caleb Ethridges Coy. and also two thirds of all my personal estate
that may be remaining after the death of my wife Mary to them
and their heirs forever
I lend the use and benefit of one third of my juniper swamp
adjoining Caleb Ethridges and also one third of all my personal
estate unto Nancy Miller wife of William Miller and after
her decease I give the third of the said Juniper Swamp and the
third of the personal estate to all the children of Nancy Miller
born of her body.
Lastly I nominate and appoint my two sons Sanford and
William Dofy as my whole and sole Executors to this my last will
and Testament nothing at other wills gift or gifts in said
will made by me but witness whereof I the said John Dofy have
hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th day May one thousand
Eight hundred and Twenty
