to settle my business after my departure,

Currituck and State of North Carolina being of Sound mind and memory  
Blessed be to God, do this second day of January in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight make his last Will and  
Testament, in manner following that is to say.

I Give and bequeath unto my Son Henry Northern the land  
and plantation, called the mill, located joining Joseph Ballou's  
line beginning at a pine, stump in Adam Wilson's line then  
along the said line to the grain swamp containing one hundred and  
fifty Acre to him and his heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath unto my Son Henry Northern the  
the Cypress Swamp that Samuel Fisher surveyed for me, beginning at  
Abraham on long ridge in William Stafford's Patent, line as hinges  
on Thomas Haymans Patent, to him and his heirs forever.

I Give and bequeath unto my Son Henry Northern my  
New entry laying between long ridge, and broad ridge, to him his heirs  
forever.

I Give and bequeath unto my Son Stephen Northern the  
Cypress Swamp that Thomas Payne surveyed for me beginning at a  
Coke on the head of East ridge and running to Maximilian  
Barnard's line to him and his heirs forever.

I Give the use and benefit of the land and plantation that  
I bought of James Wilkins formerly called Knights and joining  
Henry Ballentine's, land unto my Son Arthur Northern for the  
term of ten years, and if the said Arthur Northern should return  
within the term of ten years, then I Give the said land unto  
my Son Arthur Northern and to him and his heirs forever. But if he  
should not return within the term of ten years, I Give the said  
said land unto my Son Stephen Northern to him and his heirs forever.

I Give the use and benefit of the land and plantation that  
I bought of Isaacat Kitchen, joining Thomas Ellipse and Esq.  
Knights land also the land I bought of Jos. Hayman joining the  
line and Marmaduke Co. land unto my Son Stephen Northern  
for the term of ten years, and if he should live the said term of ten  
years then I Give the said land unto my Son Stephen Northern  
to him and his heirs forever.
