Elizabeth Blount Executrix of the last Will & Testament of William
Blount late of this County Planter Deceased exhibited in open Court the
said Will praying that it might be proved and it was then & there
proved accordingly in due Form of Law by the Oaths of John
Martin and Anna his Wife two of the Subscribing Witnesses
thereto, and thereupon ordered to be registered & the said directs
according the Will follows in these words. To wit.

In the name of God amen. I William Blount of the County of
Currituck and Province of North Carolina Planter being in
perfect Health and sound disposing mind and Memory thank
unto almighty God and knowing the uncertainty of this Life and
that it is appointed for all man once to die do constitute make and
ordain this my last Will and Testament in Manner and form following.
In witness whereof I will that all my just Debts and Funeral Charges be paid
said in convenient time after my Decease by my Executrix hereafter
named.

I then I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth all and
integral my Personal Estate and not for her to be any ways mis-
used During her natural Life and after her Decease my will
& meaning is that one half of all my said Estate I do give
& bequeath unto my Sister Rachel and to her heirs of her
lawfully begotten for ever and if it should happen to die
without such issue then my will and meaning is that the said
half of my said Estate shall fall to Brother James Biggs
William, and to his heirs for ever and the other half of my
Estate to be at my said Wife's Disposal at her Decease
why I do nominate and appoint my beloved Wife my Executrix
my last Will and Testament Disannulling all former wills by
me ratifying and confirming this to be my last will and Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal
