Plates three Stone plates four Mugs one Spitcher and one base of knives
and forks two pair of Styceras and two Ploughs to her and her
heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to Joyann Shannon thirty three head of
Hogs all my horse of every sort ten all my Axes and Chisel axes
Six chairs and one bed and one feather bed and furniture one rug
and two Blankets to her and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to Joyann Shannon all the Remainder
part of my Estate wherever to be found both within doors and
without doors to her and her heirs forever

I constitute and appoint and do Nominate Joyann Shannon
Whole and Sole Executrix to this my last will and Testament



Edward Scarborough last will and Testament I give and bequeath unto my
Sister Nancy the house and plantation until my Brother William
Son Joseph doth come of age. I give unto my brother George a certain
Tract or parcel of Land Beginning at the little Cedar Creek and running
East & back my Land to the line from thence with the line until that
we shall here west then to the Slack from thence to the point thence to
The first station I give unto my Sister Nancy James to be paid to
School on the expense of my property to pay for it I give unto
James the one fourth of my Sheep all my Land then to be divided
Between my Brother William Edward Sons Joseph and Edward
William to be equally divided between them I give unto the same
Three boys three calves and calves to the same three boys three horse
kind to the same three boys the Remainder of my Sheep my
Old house to be sold and the hogs to be equally divided between
Nancy and George and Tanny Scarborough to Joseph one bed
and furniture to my brother George the one half of my Canoe
to my brother Ignatious one Saddle to James one Gun that Mr.
Stanton hath had property to Edward and Joseph and William all my Pewter
except one Bacon that is Nancy to Joseph and Edward and William one piece
of White Linnen to be equally divided this my last will and Testament
