that all these the same day the hands of my Executor
I will give the use of my land and plantation Sharon to live to my son
John during his natural life together with all the income
there unto I will give and bequeath to my sister Elizabeth
after the death of my beloved wife the plantation and land to live
to him and his heirs for ever I will it is my will that the
Simon and my beloved wife live on the said plantation and land
as long as they open the said land and with them equal
privilege on to run my death until the death of my beloved wife
also it is my will that permiator Simon also should live on the
plantation ~~undisturbed~~ undisturbed with my wife or my
Simon and have equal with them until they should all I have
on the death of my wife may I will give and bequeath
unto permiator Simon one fether bed and furniture and a
table & pots after the death of my beloved wife or my
after my death is paid I end the use of all my money
wholly to my beloved wife during her natural life I will
I give unto permiator Simon one hundred and fifty dollars
out of my Estate to be paid to her as soon as I can
conveniently without distressing my beloved wife I will it is my
will that all the property I have not all ready written
away after the death of my wife should be William Simon
to him and his heirs forever

I will it is my will and desire that as much of the property that
I have not given away should be sold to pay my debts
I will it is my will that if not satisfied promptly enough
without taking the house and furniture to pay my debts that
my Executor should sell as much of my land as will
satisfy my debts with without distressing my beloved wife
of the many things in the house that I leave last of all
I bequeath and appoint Simon Lowry my whole and
sole Executor of this my last will and testament in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my Seal this September the 12th day 1809
