confirm this to be my last will and Testament, in manner and form following  
First I recommend my soul to God, who gave it and my body my body  
to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned

I give to my son Caleb Capps the land and plantation that I now live on  
with all the land I own to him and his heirs forever.

I give to him my hand mill to him and his heirs with one bull yearling  
and all the cattle I lent to him before.

I give to my daughter Mary Miller one bed and furniture being  
the bed I now lay on, with all the property I have at her house.

I give to my daughter Milberry barrel one bed and furniture, which  
she has in possession, likewise I give to her one bed and truss, the self  
of Chery to her and her heirs forever.

I have one cow Chery to be sold to pay my funeral expens.

The remainder of any to be equally divided between my three children  
with all the remainder of my property not given.

I constitute and appoint my son Caleb Capps, my whole and sole  
Executor of this my last will and Testament, Resolving all other wills  
By me made. Given under my hand and seal this 17<sup>th</sup> day of January

one half the money I give to who she pleases, forever the other  
half of my estate I give to Harrison Almond, except what  
I may hereafter mention,

I give to my wife Angelica Maund, one hundred dollars, at the death  
of my wife Angelica. But in case Harrison Almond should  
die without having his share then all that I have given him to  
go to his heir I mean his mother Martha, and after her death  
to go amongst the Maunds, as she law; directs. I do hereby  
constitute as well as the name Maund I appoint my wife Angelica  
My whole and sole executrix, to this my last will be, as  
Witness my hand & seal, this eighth day of October 1802
