Appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and
Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and command
My soul into the hands of Almighty God that Doth end my bodily
Presence to the world to be buried at the church of my extraction.
Nothing relating but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same
Again by the mighty power of God as is taught us in my Saviour
With place hereof a witness in this life I give of the sum of the sum
Manner and form first of all I give all my first birth to Sophia Buxley
Leave unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth one half of my negro boy and
Likewise one negro boy named Sampson likewise one half of my negro boy and
All improvements thereon one half of all my moveable property in land and
Buildings. One half of my Schooner boat fully furnished and apparelled
Twenty five acres of land lying on Roanoke River half of which
Thereon likewise one half of all the debts due and the money paid thereon
Now by me during my life and common house and slaves to my son William
Buxley likewise I give unto my daughter Elizabeth one half of all my
Estates by the name of Buxley and all her rights thereto and likewise
Two acres thereof also one acre here one her and furthermore likewise
What had likewise I give unto my Son William Buxley one negro
Boy named Borden one negro boy named Simon likewise one half of all
My lands house and all improvements thereon likewise one half of all
My moveable property as above and all monies and chattels whatsoever
And one half of the Schooner Boat to my daughter Elizabeth and all
The property that I have by me and one half of all the rest that is to say
Likewise I make institute and ordain my wife Elizabeth Buxley and
My son William Buxley sole executors of this my last will and
Testament and I do hereby strictly disallow break and disannul and void
Every other will and testament with his or her bequeathal execution by
Me in any wise before this named sealed and registered copying and
Confessing this and no other to be my last will and Testament in writing
I set my hand and seal this first day of March one thousand
Eight hundred and seven.

Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed therefore all men to die do
Make institute and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say
Principally and first of all I Give and bequeath unto my wife beloved wife
Annie Farrow my home and all my moveable property
In doors and out doors during her natural life and whatsoever for the good
and support of the Orphans she not making any thing unuseful
Or in an extravagant manner any further than is highly necessary the capital
Also I Give unto my son David W. Farrow after the death of my wife
Hood of my wife Annie Farrow my house and land with all the improvements
thereon also the whole of my moveable property after the death of my wife
of my beloved wife Annie Farrow to be equally divided amongst the
Whole of my children namely Barbara Farrow - Mahala Farrow
David W. Farrow - Delora Farrow and Lydia Farrow - Annie Farrow
Also I make institute and ordain Barbara Farrow and my wife Annie
Farrow sole executors of this my last will and Testament and I do
hereby utterly disallow break and disannul all and every other former
Testament with his or her bequeathal execution by me in my said
Before named wife and bequeathal certifying and confirming this said no
Other to be my last will and Testament in writing whereof I have here
unto set my hand and seal this seventh day of April in the year
of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and six
