 Reserving the use of the whole to my wife Lucy Williamson as long as she
 survives my widow

Secondly I Give one Negro Girl named Anne to my daughter Patsy
 Williamson Reserving the use of her to my wife as long as she lives and my
 widow and one fourth third to my daughter Patsy Reserving the use
 of it to my wife as long as she lives also one living child to my daughter
 Reserving the use of it to my wife during her natural life

Thirdly I Give to my beloved wife Lucy Williamson one Cow and
 Graveling also all my Corn and Peasch long low and Peasch two day
 Hay and I Give that my chimney should be put up on a piece of wood
 of my property that will be sold there all the Remainder part of my property
 to be sold one Equity divided between my wife and two children after paying
 my lawful debts I do hereby constitute and appoint John Dood and my wife
 Lucy Williamson Executors to this my last will and testament In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal in the year of our Lord one
