I give and Bequath to Sarah Meame A young Cow called Spotty and her Calf. Item I give and Bequath to my truly friend John McCame A book of Arithmetick and one fourth part of my cattle and last my Cloe and hymn Book Raisor and howell. Item I give and Bequath to my friend Joshua McCame, Kingote a book of Arithmetic and one fourth of my cattle Remaining half my Cloe and State. Item I give and Bequath to my true and truly friend John Gilman the Confession of faith a book and what Money is in his own hand. Item. I give and Bequath to my truly friend William McCame two Books viz: Danny and Vincent My Scale and Scales &c. Last of all I constitute and appoint My true and truly friend John McCame and William McCame My sole Executors to this my Last will and Testament.
