In the Name of God Amen I William Duacks being this
19th day of July 1770 Very sick but of sound and perfect
Memory thanks be to God for the same and calling to mind
that it is appointed once for all men once to die, And I
Recommending my soul into the hands of the Almighty
God that gave, And body to be buried in a Christian decent
manner at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named
and Touching such worldly goods as it hath been Pleas'd
God to bestow me I give and bequeath them in manner
and form following To wit: Item I bequeath my will
belong wife Mary a Jane Duacks the Plantation where I
now live during her widowhood and all my household goods
Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Cammer
one bill to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give unto
my son Presley Duacks one cow and calf to him and
his heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my son William
Duacks one colt and one cow and calf to him and his
heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my son Robert
Duacks one colt and one cow and calf to him and his heirs
for ever. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Selah
Duacks one Cow and calf to her and her heirs for ever.
Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Rhode Duacks one
bible to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath
to my son Henry Duacks the Plantation where I now live
to him and his heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath

to my daughter Elizabeth and Nannis Duacks three head of
small Cattle to live and his heirs for ever. Item I also
bequeath unto my will beloved wife all the rest of my
Estate not yet mentioned both Real and personal unto her
during her widowhood and then to be Equal divided
between her and my five youngest Children Selah, Rhoda,
Henry, Elizabeth, and Nancy Duacks to them and their
heirs for ever. And further I do nominate and appoint
my Trusty friend Rm Blackmore Executor of this my
Last Will and Testament. And I do disannul all other
former wills to be void and of none effect. And I do declare
this to be my last Will and Testament In Testimony where
of I have hereunto Set my hand and fixed my seal the day

mind and memory do make and order this to be my last Will
and Testament in manner and form following. First I
Command my Soul to God and my Body to the Dust to be
buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter to be named
my worldly goods, I dispose of as followeth. Item I bequeath
to my beloved Wife Fanny Duackin the Land and plantation
where I now live and also the hole of my household and
kitchen furniture and my two young mares and my Riding
Chair and Hunting Saddle. Also the hole of my stock of
Hogs and sheep & four cows and calves or yearlings and
one Heifer Also my cart and all my plantation tools of
Every Description and one Bar of Iron and what sault I
have by me at this time and what corn and other provisions
