 And I give the work and labor of my Negro Phillis to my grand son Isaac Thomas but her child Pats to my other grand son William Thomas when he shall arrive to the age of twenty one years ~~and~~ but to be under the Care of my daughter Rachel Rhoads and the Rest of the Estate of the said Phillis to the Children of my son Wm Thomas until each shall have one share the share that may be born to my grand son Isaac Thomas and his heirs forever and when my grandson Isaac Thomas be called to the world then Phillis & what Children may be under the Care of my daughter Rachel Rhoads until he comes back and the Plantation to be under the Care of his Father Wm Thomas for the last benefit of my said grand son Isaac Thomas. The furniture as follows one large Pair of Iron Doggs find in the chimney stove Pinter dishes six plates one Iron Stove & Tongs one Box Iron & 2 Chests three Pinter Basins one of a Gallon one of 2 Quarts one of one Quart one Hair Glass one pair Billiard 3 Iron Pots one of three Gallons one of 5 Gallons one of eight Gallons two Iron Shoulders one Iron one Tray one Iron one Brass Kettle one Elbow Chair 1/2 Chair one Table one Case with twelve Rattle one Sofa five Knives & forks one pair of Silver Buckles one Shoe brush one my shirt one my watch & the rest of my wearing apparel except my new Brass Coat which is for my son Philip Thomas.
 And I give my Negro Boy Dover above whom I have sold to my grand son Richard Thomas when he comes of age of twenty one years and his heirs forever but the work and labor of said Boy to my son William Thomas in consideration of his Care and Clothing of the said Boy And I give Silver and Bequeath unto my son Billy Thomas two hundred Acres of Uncultivated Land on Broad Branch and one hundred Acres & eight farming the land I give on and my son Philip and all my Cattle
