I Daniel Teachey of the State of North Carolina and County of Duplin, Being aged and informed Best of Perfect mind and Memory blessed be God. at the same time Calling to mind the uncertainty of Human life and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do now and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit: I bequeath my land to Caroline gave it me and my body to have receipt and Christian bequeath at the discretion of my Executors hereafter to be named.

2<sup>d</sup> I will and ordain that my Executors do see so much of the most divisible part of Estate as will be sufficient to discharge my just debts & personal Expenses —

3<sup>d</sup> I will and ordain that my beloved wife Anne Teachey do have quiet and peaceable disposition of all that part of my land to the east of the Iron Mine Branch joining Daniel Teachey Jr and the land that was formerly John Teachey and known by the name of Lime place during her Widowhood and at her decease it be the property of my son Timothy Teachey and of his heirs forever.

4<sup>th</sup> I will and ordain that my beloved wife Anne Teachey shall have during her natural life or widowhood the following Negroes to wit: Prince Sophia Kate, Jon Salters Jack Nacey and her child Hannah and her child as also all my Stock Cattle Horses Sheep Hags &c. together with all my House hold furniture and plantation Tools of every nature or kind whatsoever.

5<sup>th</sup> I will and ordain that after my wife decease my Negroes Wench Nancy and her child Hannah and this increase from this date be the property of my son James Teachey and of his heirs forever.

6<sup>th</sup> I will and ordain that after the decease of my wife Anne Teachey the following Negroes be equally divided Between my two sons Daniel Teachey & Timothy Teachey to wit: Prince Sophia Kate & Jon Salters Jack & Kate together with all my House hold furniture and Stock of every kind whatever with all my plantation tools and the increase of the female Negroes above named from this date to them and their heirs forever.

forever I also will and ordain that James James Negro Wench Fortune Rags Nancy and child do remain in the possession of my beloved wife during her Widowhood or natural life and that after her marriage or her decease they be equally divided Between my two sons Daniel Teachey & Timothy Teachey and the issue they may have from this date to the time of said division to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Jacob Teachey ten hundred acres of land including the Plantation whereon he now lives on the West side of the Iron Mine Branch joining Womonic Runjo line and Daniel Teachey to him and his heirs forever Item I give and bequeath to my son Jacob Teachey one Negro Man Slave named Billy to him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my son Daniel Teachey one Negro Slave named Perry and one Negro Girl Slave named Army with her increase from this date forward to him and his heirs forever Item I give and bequeath to my son Timothy Teachey one Negro Boy named Tony and one Wench named Nager and her child named Nancy and this increase from this date forward to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary born one Negro Wench named Grace together with her increase from this date forward to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Barbara of George one Negro Girl named Lucy and her increase from this date and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Teachey five Shillings Money to him and his heirs forever — Item I give and give and bequeath to my daughter Catharine Boney five Shillings Sterling Money to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my grand son Daniel Teachey son of John Teachey Ten pounds specie to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my grand son Daniel Boney Ten pounds specie and his heirs forever Item I give and bequeath to my grand son Teachey Cow Ten pounds specie to him and his heirs forever Item I give and bequeath to my grand son Daniel George Ten pounds specie to him and his heirs forever and lastly I Nominate constitute and appoint my beloved wife Anne Teachey

Executors and my son Daniel Teachey and Timothy Teachey  
 Executors to this my last will & testament hereby revoking  
 all other wills and testaments by me made in witness whereof  
 I the said Daniel Teachey have hereunto set my hand and  
 seal published this thirteenth day of February in the 10th  
 year of annexation and independence and in the year of our  
 Lord 1791 — Daniel Teachey <sup>mark</sup> Test

I Joseph J. in the name of God do hereby know all men by these  
 presents that I Jacob Teachey planter and deceased and late in  
 health fit of sound disposing Mind do hereby make and ordain this  
 my last will and testament first I give my soul to God who  
 gave it and secondly I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife  
 Nancy Teachey all and singular of my worldly Estate after my first  
 debts are paid during her lifetime or widowhood then I give and  
 bequeath unto my son Isaac Teachey two hundred acres of  
 land lying on any branch the upper part joining the Main Road  
 Thirdly I will and bequeath unto Alfred Teachey two hundred acres  
 of land lying on any branch being part of the land left  
 me by J. T. Reed. Fourthly I will and bequeath unto Daniel  
 Teachey my younger son a certain tract of land lying on the  
 East Side of the N<sup>c</sup> River known by the name of Horse Knapp  
 fifthly after the death of ~~my~~ <sup>the</sup> widow or sister Mary the  
 remainder of the worldly property equally divided among the  
 surviving lawful heirs except my Negro Man Stevan who shall  
 equally belong to Isaac Teachey and Alfred Teachey forever  
 In witness whereof I have done my hand and fix my seal in  
 the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty  
 eight Jacob Teachey Test
