I do hereby constitute and nominate and appoint my beloved and trusty sons Bryan and Henry Komigay as executors to this my last will and Testament given under my hand and seal this the 10th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six. I George Komigay being weak in body but of perfect mind and sound memory knowing it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this to be my last will and Testament, first I recommend my soul to God who gave it and my body to be decently buried by my Executor hereafter named and as to such worldly goods

as it has been pleased Almighty God to bless me with I dispose of as follows. First, I give and bequeath to my son George Komigay beside the land he lives on and the other property he has already received with the negroes Tony and Charles Bobi Haner and Cato to him and his heirs. Item I give unto my daughter Lively and her husband John Komigay one mare and bridle one bed and furniture and four cows and calves, all of which they have personally used. I also lend unto S^t Luell and her husband John the following negroes (viz) Esther and all her children and one boy named Jacke during my life this my will and desire is that S^t negroes be under the care of my son Daniel and the profits, arising from them to be applied to the support of S^t Luell during her life and after her decease the whole of S^t Negro to be equally divided amongst her children. Item I give and bequeath to my son Daniel Komigay beside the land he lives on and the other property he has not with the negroes Jimmy and Lacey and all her children which he has in possession one boy named Jim and three cows and Hifers and yearling to make six head to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my son David Komigay beside the land he lives on, the following negroes that he has in possession viz. Violet, Will, Gus and little Lou and a boy named Mathus and one hundred Dollars in money to him and his heirs. Item I give and bequeath to my two sons Bavel and Jacob Komigay all the residue or remainder of my negroes not hitherto mentioned in the will to be equally divided between them the S^t Bavel and Jacob or their heirs. Item I give unto my wife Moorem Komigay one horse named Surp and my riding chair to her and her heirs. My will and desire further is that after all my just debts be paid that my son Bavel pay my son Jacob five hundred Dollars out of my Estate.

and that the residue or remainder of all my other property be it of what soever nature, it may not before mentioned shall be equally divided between them S^d Basil and Jacob Komigay and their heirs forever (except my stock of Cattle which I give to my son Basil Komigay and his heirs).

Lastly I nominate and appoint my two sons Basil and Jacob Komigay Executors of this my last will and Testament, declared this and this only to be my last will and finally, I do hereby revoke and disannul all former wills heretofore made. In witness whereof I the S^d George Komigay Senr, have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3rd day of January A.D. 1808.
