And Next I give and bequeath unto Howel Hunter son of William Hunter fifty dollars \$50. Next I give and bequeath unto William Wright Hollingsworth fifty dollars \$50. Next I give and bequeath unto the boy now with me and bound to me Frederick Picket Jr. fifty dollars \$50. Next I give and bequeath unto John McCann Sr. fifty dollars \$50. Next I give and bequeath unto John Gaugh twenty dollars \$20. Next I give and bequeath unto Zekiah Grant. fifteen dollars \$15. Next I give and bequeath unto Benjamin Padget fifteen dollars \$15. Next I give and bequeath unto Margaret Manning Twenty five dollars \$25. If I give and bequeath unto Sally Luga Manning twenty five dollars \$25. Next as I have bestowed on some of my friends under age at present it is my will and intention therefore that if one or all or any part of the afore mentioned minors should die before they become the age of twenty one that then in that case the afore mentioned sum or sums herein given to them to be given to my four brothers to wit. Ned John, William & Nicol Hunter and and last by if then should be any surplus of my estate left after the afore mentioned division takes place and all my just debts is paid with every occurring expence that then and in that case the residue remaining to be divided between all mentioned in the above will who is now of the age of twenty one the division to be not exactly equal but in proportion to what is laid of to them in the afore

Mentioned well as when I have given as a small
downing the remaining divide to be small in proportion
to the larger ones. Lastly I nominate and appoint
John Mc Canna Jr my whole executor to this my last

Nancy, one bed and furniture and bedsted and cow &
a three year old heifer and a three year old steer and
one Ewe, and the remainder of the shop to my well
beloved wife Mary during her lifetime thence to be equally
dividied among the children also four cows and calves
two three year old steers and two year old steers. I also
give and bequeath to my well beloved son Jess. One

tract of land containing two hundred acres lying on
the river Darr swamp in New Hanover County also one
cow and year old steer. I also give and bequeath to my
well beloved son Richard one plantation containing two
hundred acres of land lying in Duplin County on the
Great Swamp one cow and calf. I also give and bequeath
to my well beloved daughter Elizabeth one three year
old heifer and one two year old steer and one sick. Also
I give and bequeath to my well beloved daughter Henry
one cow and calf. Also to my daughter in law Sarah
one three year old heifer and one sow and pigs also
to my daughter Nancy as named above one small
pot and five plates and 2 gear also to my wife as
above named two pots, ten plates, and soon basom &
three dishes and one pair of stidyards and her some
the steel yards to my son Jess. and I also give to my
above named daughter in law Sarah two plates and all
my working tools to my above named wife Mary during her
life time thence to her Equally divided between my above
named two sons Jess and Richard and also the above
plantation which I have left to my wife as above mentioned
at her decease to be the property of my son Jess. and I
give to my above named wife Mary all the remainder of
my house hold furniture with all the hogs and all the gees
and every other thing of my property which is not here
mentionned, and I hereby make and ordain my well
beloved wife Mary Christ and my Loving Brother in law
Thomas Fort. Executor and Executrix of this my last will
and testament in witness whereof the said Jesus
Christ have to this my last will and testament set
my hand and seal the day and year above written.
