Item I give to my Son John one Negro Boy named Charles
 and one Negro Boy named Harry

Item I give to my daughter Dorothy one Negro girl named
 Nancy and one Negro Girl named Jane

Item I likewise give to each of my said Children a feather Bed
 duvet & that the remainder part of my Estate be equally divided
 among my Children and that my Beloved Brother
 Gabriel Harris be hereby appointed my lawful Executor
 and I do hereby declare this to be my last Will and
 Testemant as Witness My Hand and Seal this Eleventh day of
 January and in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven
 hundred and Sixty one let no man interfere beyond

 Carolina Being in a low state of body health but in perfect
 Mind and Memory and calling to mind that it is appointed for
 mankind once to die I therefore make and declare this to be
 my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows
 1781

First and principally I bequeath my Soul to the care of Almighty
 God who gave it keeping on Jesus Christ for Resuscitation
 My Body leave my Lady I Commit to the Earth from whence
 it Came to埋葬in a Christian like Manner at the discretion
 of my surviving friends &c

Item In Consideration of Bringing up Training and Educating
 my Children & giving and bequeath to my beloved Wife dear
 Thomas all my Horse and Plantation to all houses house and
 Kitchen furniture not other ways than after disposal of
 during her Natural life. I also leave her all and the labor
 of my Negroes which is Mac and and when during their
 life according division is of said Negroes Marsh does not
 behavior we becometh a just Servant that he be freed and

Item I leave the rest of all my lands and plantation wherow
 I now live to my beloved Wife during her Natural
 life for her & my Children Support

Item I give and bequeath to my Son William Homes my Negro boy
 Bob to him his heirs &c training his labor only to his
 Mother for her use of the family until my said Son comes
 to the age of Twenty one years.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son James Homes one

Negro boy named Dennis to him his heirs &c. Reserving
as above.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Thomas one
sixth part of my Stock of my Cattle and Stock of Hogs and
one feather bed and Furniture also a sixth part of my bed
and Household Furniture to be allotted off to her at her Marriage
or Connexion woman's age

I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Thomas one six
part of Stock of Cattle & Hogs also Household Furniture and
one feather bed to be allotted off to her at her Marriage or Conn
of woman's age

I give and bequeath to my daughter Moreinda Thomas
one sixth part of my Stock of Cattle, Hogs and Household
Furniture also one feather bed & furniture to be allotted off
to her at her Marriage or Connexion woman's age

I give and bequeath to my daughter Dolly Thomas one
sixth part of my Stock of Cattle and Hogs and Household
Furniture, one feather bed & furniture to be allotted off
to her at her Marriage or Connexion of woman's age

I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Thomas one
sixth part of my Household Furniture one feather bed
presenting to her all at her Marriage or
Connexion of woman's age

I give and bequeath to my son Lewis Thomas one sixth
part of my Stock of Cattle & Hogs one sixth of my Household
Furniture one feather bed and Furniture to be allotted
him when Marryed or arrive at Twenty one years age

I give and bequeath all my Lands that I possess to be
Equally divided between my Son William Thomas Lewis Thomas
and Lewis Thomas after the death of my wife to them to be
and assignes forever

I do hereby and appoint my friend Lewis Jones and
Robert Saunderson Esquires Executors to this my last will
and testament In witness whereof I have signed my hand
and Seal the 22nd day of January in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and three
