 to one of the heirs of her body. Also I give and
 bequeath to my daughter Jane Hall my negro man
 Brahm, for and during her natural life, and at
 her death (should she have issue) to her child, or if
 more than one child to such one as she may
 direct. Provided such child arrives to the age of
 twenty-one years. But if my said daughter Jane
 should die leaving no child, or such child not live
 to the age of twenty-one years, then to my grandson
 Thomas L Kuman son of Thomas Kuman to him
 and his heirs for ever. Also, I give and bequeath to my
 grand daughter Catherine C Price our bed, sidest and
 furniture, to her and her heirs. It is also my will and
 desire that my grand daughter Sarah Holmes should
 receive out of my Estate, ten dollars in cash. All
 the residue of my Estate I give to my six children
 to be equally divided amongst them. And I do hereby
 constitute and appoint my sons Thomas Kuman and
 Daniel L Kuman Executors to this my last will and
 testament, In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set
 my hand this 18th day of May in the year of our Lord 1816.

 being of sound mind and knowing that it is
 appointed for man to die, Do make and ordain
 this my last will and testament in manner &
 form following (That is to say) First and principally
 I recommend my soul to God that gave it and
 my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian
 manner, at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
 named — And as to such worldly Estate as it
 hath pleased God to bless me with in this life.
 I give and dispose of in the following manner.
 First it is my will that all my just debts
 should be paid out of such part of my Estate
 that my Executors may think proper. Item, I
 give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Kuman
 my house wench Carter and all her children.
 Item, I give and bequeath to my son Daniel L^r
 Kuman two yellow men slaves (to wit) Dick and
 Moses. to him and her heirs for ever. With my
 plantation and all my lands, joining the
 same and also all my other lands of every kind
 (Except my Executors should think proper to dispose
 of any of the lightwood land to pay my debts.
 (In that case I leave it to their discretion) and
 all the remainder part I give to him and his
 heirs forever. Item, I give and bequeath to my son
 Thomas Kuman, my negro wench Polly and her child
 Henry, also I will and bequeath to him all and
 singular, C. tract or parcel of land, patented
 by myself, and sold apart to Benjamin Johnston
 and James Ferris, and the balance I give to
 Thomas Kuman him and his heirs for ever. Item
 I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Kuman

my negro wench Thane and all her children to her and her heirs forever. Item. I will and bequeth to my daughter Jane Kuman my negro wench Bager and her children and also my negro boy Isaac to her and her heirs forever. Item. I will and bequeth to my Grand Daughter Sarah Horment my negro boy Ireland. Item. It is also my will and desire that my Executors dispose of and sell as they may think proper such part of my stock to discharge my debts and all the rest of my Estate, consisting of negroes, cattle, Hogs, sheep, Horses, plantation tools Kitchen furniture of every kind and all my House hold furniture I leave to my wife Sarah during her natural life and at her death to be equally divided among all my children (that is to say) The shares drawn by Elizabeth Price my daughter and Susannah Price my daughter I will and bequeth to their children to be equally divided among them and to no others. And it is my will. If Catherine Kuman should survive my wife she shall be maintained out of my Estate I do hereby constitute and appoint Thomas Kuman and Daniel Low Kuman Executors to this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me made this and only this, to be my last will. Item I give and bequeth unto my Daughter Penelope Antin five shillings. Item I give and bequeth unto my son Michael J Kuman one half of a still also five shillings. Item I give and bequeth unto my daughter in law Nellie Kuman five shillings. And I hereby make and ordain my worthy friends Richard Clinton and George Morricey Executors of this my last will and Testament.
