as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hapneth please
God to bless me with in this world life.

I give and divide and dispose of the same in the following
Manner and form First of all I make and appoint my
loving son Ickan and Ephraim Sholar my true Execut
to this my last will and testament. It is my will and desire
that my sole Estate shal be sold to the highest bidder Sir
Morris Cradit to be having given I give to my beloved son
Ephraim Sholar One hundred and Seventeen Gallons when
Collected, all my just debts to be paid. Likewise give to my
beloved son Ickan Sholar Seventeen Gallons and after
this an Equal Division to both please herein my two
Wives and to do thereby utterly disallow herself and
disannul and void other former testaments & wills legacies
bequeath and Executors by me in any wise before named
Written and begeth fortifying and confirming this
and no other to be my last will and testament witness
whereas I have written set my hand and seal September 10th
1872

shall receive the same again by the Mighty power of God touching
My worldly estate wherewith it hath been please God to bless me
in this life I give this and dispose of the same so the money
and form top. Imprimis I give and bequeath to my well
beloved wife Elizabeth Snell my negro boy named Nat, to her and
her heirs and my horses and Mares and my Cattle and my pigs
and my bed and Furniture and all the rest of my Household
goods and furniture that I now hold in my possession
to her and her heirs. Item I give the Child that my wife is
now bearing with my negro boy named Ben of the Child to his wife
it comes of age and of the child with the sum of Comes of
age. I give the said Negro to my well beloved brother Roger
Snell further more I give to the child as my wife is now
bearing with one thousand and fifty acres of land lying on
the East side of the Six river Swamp below Abraham Kings
joining to Abraham Kings land.

Item I give to my well beloved brother Roger Snell my
Negro fellow Ben and all the rest of my estate that is
now in my Mothers hands to him and his offspres
see no end I likewise constitute myself and ordain
Roger Snell and George Bell my only and sole Execut
of this my last will and testament and I do hereby

utterly disavow and disallow every other and former
Testaments in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal the day and year above written signed Sealed subscribed
and discharged by the said as his last Will and Testament & doth
presente & us the subscribers

Doomed at Auguest Term 1762

A Memorandum of the desirous of William Thomas on his
death Bed to wit. He desired that his son John Thomas
Should have the Mainier plantation containing one hundred
Acre he also desired that his son Benjamin Thomas
Should have the plantation that S Benjamin was
living on with the land belonging to the S Surveyor he
also desired that his grandsons Egidus Carter and
Lawrence Thomas should have two hundred acres
of land lying on the waters of Cutters to be equally divided
between his ~~children~~ the S^t Egidus and Lawrence like
also desired that all his stock of cattle should be
equally divided Between his children June 11th 1785.
This day the undersubscribers witness came before me
Made oath that the above witness was what they knew
William Thomas desirous on his death Bed June 9th 1785

Twenty fifth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand
Eight Hundred and one made and published this my last Will and
Testament in manner following that is to say —

I give and bequeath unto my Son Joseph Underhill my dearest
girl Maria Luisa and not to have her until the death of my beloved
Wife Lydia Underhill & it is my desire that my son George
Underhill have the first Child after the said Lydia die
Luisa shall have —

Item I give unto my Son William Underhill all the Money due me
from Robert Monroe which is Forty Pounds ten Shillings & six
Money he overcame which is Six pounds

Item It is my desire that the Money due me for my Lanes from Lucy
Bland should be laid out with the purchase of other lands
and that my beloved wife Lydia Underhill have a quiet and
peaceable possession of the same during her life time and then to be
equally & divided between my two Sons Joseph Underhill
and Jerry Underhill

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Lydia Underhill
all the rest of my property that has not already been named
also the use of my Negro girl Lydia during her natural life

Item I give unto my Son in law William Thompson his Shillings.

Item I give unto my Daughter Sarah Marshall his Shillings

Item I give unto my Anna Underhill his Shillings
and I hereby make and ordain my above named Lydia
Underhill and my working girl John Ann and William
Pellow Executors to this my last Will and Testament
in witness whereof I did sign William Underhill here & there
my last Will and Testament by my hand and seal the day
and year above written signed sealed published and declared
by the said William Underhill the testator as his last
Will and Testament in the presence of us who were present
at the time of signing and sealing thereof
