Negelin County I Stephen Williams being of sound mind and memory  
blessed be good for the same do make and publish this  
this my last will and Testament. After my death all of my worldly estate  
Machinery & after the following manners. I give to my beloved wife  
during her natural life my plantation Wherow I live all of my Cattle  
Horses, Hog & Sheep but after her death to be divided as follows.  
All the land that I have in the North East Side of Rockfish Creek  
as far as the mouth of said Creek must be divided between  
my three daughters Elizabeth Phelps and Jephtha and all of my land  
lying on the South Side of Rockfish Creek as far as the mouth  
of said Creek I give to my grandson James S. Johnson and all of  
my land lying on Taylors Creek I give to my grandson George  
Washington Williams after the death of my wife. My stock to be  
divided as follows. I give to my grandson James S. Johnson  
and three of my daughters to wit Elizabeth Phelps & Jephtha one  
half of my stock of Cattle and Sheep and the remaining half of  
Cattle and Sheep I give to my two daughters Bridget and Mary,  
I give to my three daughters to wit Elizabeth Phelps and Jephtha  
all of my stock of Horses and Hogs.

As for daughter Mary it is my desire that she remain with my son  
James S. Johnson or her three sisters to wit Elizabeth Phelps and Jephtha  
(at his pleasure) and that they furnish her every comfortable  
necessity of life (but in no wise subject to the benefit of her  
husband Isaac Wilson) but if he should die and said Mary be improper  
to emigrate from her three sisters or my grandson above mentioned  
then in that event they may guardians and three daughters  
above mentioned shall not feel themselves bound by her marriage  
Also in addition to what I have heretofore given my daughter Mary  
I now give her the sum of One hundred As to my household  
and Kitchen furniture growing utensil &c & all such  
my wife and after her death my daughter Mary must have  
one chamber bed and my grandson James S. Johnson must have  
one feather bed and its necessary furniture the remaining part  
& my house hold and Kitchen furniture & family utensils  
of all description I give to Elizabeth Phelps and Jephtha

Also all Cook Notes or accounts that may be on hand after  
the death of my wife must be divided between Elizabeth Phelps and  
Jephtha but subject to the benefit of my wife during her natural  
life I do hereby nominate & appoint to take my Son in law  
Stephen Williams and grandson James S. Johnson my executors  
to this my last will and Testament this 23 day of May in the year of  
One thousand eight hundred and forty

I James Miller of the County of Negelin said State of North Carolina  
being in a low State of Health but of sound mind and memory  
but knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do  
therefore this 22 day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand  
Eight hundred and twenty nine Publish this as my last will  
and Testament in manner and form following (viz) first I  
recommend my soul to God who first gave it me and my body  
to the dust to rest in a Christian like manner at the discretion  
of my surviving friends

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Ann Miller during natural  
lifetime for mensal Rent one third part of Cattle after paying up  
the money due are moreover set for one Sow and Pigs and all of my  
Sheep and all of my House hold property and Kitchen furniture and  
Plantation Tools as so much thereof as she may think sufficient  
for her own Benefit

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Rogers the whole

of my land and plantation whereon I have been during her natural life time and after her death to go to her son Thomas Rogers forever only reserving one third of the same for my beloved wife Sarah Waller.

Item. \$300 and the balance of my property which is not mentioned in my last will and testament I leave to be sold by my executors to pay my just debts and my funeral charges and the balance if any left appointed to the support of my beloved wife Sarah Waller during her life time.

Finally and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my worthy friend & sole Executor to this my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and date first above written SIGNED Sealed and pronounced witness James Waller Read Preacher of c/o.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Susan Hoad my negro woman Abby one bed, bolster and two pillows and the other half of the best clocke that I may die possessed of

Item I give and bequeath to my son William Dicson one bed which he has already received.

Item I give to my grand son Thomas Armstrong one bed & furniture which is to be furnished with bolster, pillow, sheets & curtains &c. before the division to be given between Lincoln Shufeld and Susan Hoads.

Item I wish all my household furniture not mentioned in this will, my kitchen furniture, Stove, & in fine everything not mentioned herein to be sold and the money to be equally divided betwix Lincoln Shufeld, Susan Hoads, William Dicson and the children of Edward Armstrong, the children of Ed. Armstrong having one fourth of it equally divided among them.

Lastly I constitute & appoint David Hoads Executor to this my last will & testament, in testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal, the 10th day of February A.D. 1827.
