I dispose of the same in manner and form following that is to say I leave and bequeath to my son John Johnston Senior the plantation I now live on the S<sup>d</sup> plantation granted me by deed from William M<sup>r</sup> Ree provided all ways that my said son John shall and will give or cause to give to my two daughters Elizabeth Johnston and Hannah Johnston three hundred acres of Land to the S<sup>d</sup> Elizabeth Johnston and three hundred to the S<sup>d</sup> Hannah Johnston three hundred to Beat Stewart's Creek Libourne three hundred acres of the Land belonging to or joining this plantation where it may be thought most convenient by select men for that purpose and if in case my sd son John shall faithfully perform and give S<sup>d</sup> Lands as above said then I do order and my will is that my sd son shall have full Rights and claim to my plantation where I now live but in case of failure on his part of giving the Lands to my S<sup>d</sup> daughter Elizabeth and Hannah above said then I order and my will is that my S<sup>d</sup> daughter Elizabeth and Hannah shall have my plantation to be divided between them share & share alike and further I do order and my will is that my thirds be divided between them share and share alike keeping three cows and calves to be given to other three children one apiece. But be it remembered that in case my S<sup>d</sup> son shall perform the within bargained Lands then I do order and my will is that my sd son shall have an equal part of my thirds for the same making and performing of the within. I have hereunto set my hand and seal as my Last will Testament in presence of those whom saw me sign, seal and deliver this as my last will and Testament. 10<sup>th</sup> 1777. W. B. My will

That Jesse Jones being sick told this deponent that he had a negr woman named Cato near Newbern which was Ranaway at that time and a certain man not remembering his name was to have the service of her ten months for catching her and after the expiration of ten months when lawfully was to take possession of her the said negr woman Cato and keep her until he called for her it was his wish that if he never called for her that Owen Connerly was to keep her for he had rather he would have her than any other person the above being sworn to before me this 9<sup>th</sup> day of September 1815. I also give and bequeath to my mother my mare, feather bed and furniture during her natural life and after her death my will is that my beloved Brother Gabriel H James have my mare & my niece Rebecca James my bed. Secondly. I give and bequeath unto my beloved nephew James Tachy one hundred dollars to be raised by the hire of negroes for also my just debts to be paid by the hire of said negroes. I appoint and request my nephew James Tachy to be my Executor to this my last will and testament the day and date aforesaid. Signed sealed and

(Item 3) I also give and bequeath to my Sisters Frances, Sytha, Jane and Rachel or their heirs one dollar each and no more. (Item 4) I also give and bequeath unto Ann Owens daughter of Lewis Ryall, one dollar and no more. (Item 5) I also give and bequeath to Beverly Ryland, one dollar and no more.
