I give and bequeath to my two children Amy Jane Beck & William Jake Beck to them and their heirs forever all the residue of my personal estate after my just debts are paid to be equally divided to them thence at the time my daughter Amy Jane Beck arrives at the age of twenty one years or get married. Item my will & desire that my plantation tract a parcel of land containing nine hundred acres be the same more or less situated being and lying in the County of Robeson that I purchased from James and Archibald McFail of said county should be sold by my executors which I vest with full power and authority to give a good and lawful title in fee simple. Item my will and desire that one third part of the money arising from the sale of the tract lying in Robeson County should be by my executors laid out for a convenient plantation for my beloved wife said mare Beck which said plantation which purchased I had to my beloved wife during her natural life item after the decease of my beloved wife my desire is that the said plantation should be equally divided between my two children Amy Jane Beck & W. J. Beck to them and their heirs forever the residue of the money arising from the sale of said land in the county of Robeson what collected by my executors my desire is should be laid for likely young negroes which I give to my two children James Beck & W. J. Beck to have and them heirs forever to be divided between them at the age of twenty one years or at the marriage of my said daughter and I do hereby revoke and make null and void other will or wills hereto fore by me made and I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Sarah M. Beck and my brother John Beck my executors to this my last will and testament signed sealed and executed this 7th of February 1804 in presence of Levi Bondin Alfred Beck B. Homeguy

 in body out of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for it  
 and calling to mind the mortality of all mankind do  
 make this my last will and testament that is to say first of all  
 I recommend my soul unto God who gave it to me at first nothing  
 doubting but I shall receive the same again at the general  
 resurrection by the power of Almighty God and my body I re-  
 commend to the earth to be buried in a decent & christianlike  
 & decent manner at the discretion of my executors and as  
 touching such worldly estate where with it has pleased god to  
 bless me with this life & dispose of in manner & form as  
 follows Viz first of all my desire is it to all my just debt  
 and shall be paid also my funeral charges be paid. Item  
 I leave unto my beloved wife my plantation where I now live  
 or also the plantations tools. Item I give and bequeath unto  
 my beloved daughter Mary Brown all the stock of cattle &  
 hogs marked in a mark for her Item I leave to my beloved  
 wife Lidea all stocks of cattle & hogs and all the rest of my  
 hole estate with my plantation and all kind of tools during  
 her widow hood except one bay mare and two cows and  
 Calves. Item I give and bequeath the same bay mare unto my  
 beloved son Howell Brown when he comes of ratiun age or at  
 the marriage of my wife. Item my desire is if my wife shall marry that  
 she shall have one third part of my land during her life and all  
 the rest of my hole estate shall be equally divided between the  
 rest of my children excepting my beloved daughter Mary beloved  
 son Howell. Item I give unto them both Mary & Howell ten pounds  
 in money at my wife marriage or else. Item I give and bequeath  
 to my beloved son Howell Brown & John Brown three hundred  
 acres of land adjoining ~~my~~ plantation whereon I now live. Item  
 my desire is that all the rest of my hole estate shall be sold  
 and equally divided between my beloved daughter Mary and my  
 other two sons Felix Brown & Frederick Brown at the marriage  
 of my wife or death. and I do make & renew this my last will & testament and by these  
 presents revoke & reverse all other wills & do constitute this my last will & testament and do leave Benjamin &  
 Moses naming my hole sole executors in whom whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal - 4th April 1801
