 God. Therefore and calling to mind that all men is appointed
 to die do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament

John Cook hereby revoking all others. First I give my body to the dust
 from whence it came to be buried in a decent and christian
 like manner at the discretion of my Exes hereafter to be mentioned
 and my soul to God that gave it it not doubting but I shall
 be raged up at the day of the resurrection and be led into
 glory through the merits of Jesus Christ my redeemer in whom
 I trust. First I give the plantation & land on which I now

live. to my two sons Henry Cook & Lewis Cook to be divided equally in value at the discretion of my Exr So as the upper bridge where I now live shall be long. to Lewis Cook above mentioned now while my belove wife Cathin Cook is to have peareble possession of the plantation where I now live during her natural life nevertheless if she think fit to live this Count and not remain throug the whole use of the plantation to belong to Lewis Cook my secon son from as already mentioned. I also give and bequeath to my son John Cook one tract of land on Island Creek Contain one hundred and fifty acres be the same man or less to him and his fower. I also give to my wife Cathin one gray mare name Fune and the use of the others whilist the family remain together and having ares to the age of twenty one then he to do with them as he may think fit remaining the remainder in of this the remainder of the time Henry is also to have three two year old heifrs and pay his part of the debts and annuall I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary two cows & calfs and one two year old heifur and one bed & furniture already made huse and no more the remainder of the huse to belong to my wife and the rest of my children namely Lewis & John Cook to be divided when as my Exs may think best I also give and bequeath to my wife & the cheldren from Lewis & John Cook all my huse hold furniture and the plantation tools for their support and payment of debts and to be divided at what time and what manner they Exs may think best so as to prevent any public scail of any part of my estate mean my Exs and lastly to constitude and appoint my beloved wife Cathin Cook and Robt Dresser Exr my Exs of this my last will & testamant in writing whereof I do hereunto set my hand & fix my seal the day and date above written in the presence of no Andrew Threlly John Cook John ^{his} Cook ~~mark~~ seal.
