Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved sons James Isaac William and Major Newton all my land and rights of land to be equally divided between them for by men of their own choosing to them and their heirs forever. When William Newton becomes to the age of twenty one years of age. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Cloy and Susannah Newton all my claim, rights and title to a certain negro ^{named} wench, doll and all her issue which are at this time three named Doves Peter and more to them and their heirs for ever. Item I do likewise give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Newton our bed and furniture also two cows and calves to be disposed at her own discretion amongst my beloved children at her death and all household furniture. Item I likewise do give and bequeath unto my beloved son James Newton one bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever. Likewise I give and bequeath unto my loving sons Isaac William and Major Newton two Cows & calves each to them and their heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Cloy and Susannah Newton our bed and furniture. each to them and their heirs forever. Item all the remainder of my property to be sold at public

sale to satisfy my Creditors and if any remains to be applied to educate and raise my children. Item I also constitute and appoint my trusty friend Colonel William Dickson and James Reardon and Mary Newton Executors of this my last will and Testament lastly I publish and declare this my last will and Testament. disavowing and revoking all other wills or bequests by me made heretofore.  of my body and knowing that it is appointed
 for all men once to die, do make and ordain

this my last will and Testament, that is to
 say First of all I constitute and ordain Aaron
 Williams and Enoch Newton Executors of this my
 last will and Testament and as touching my
 world Estate I give and dispose of the same
 in the following form and manner first I give
 and bequeath unto my two sons Enoch and Isaac
 Newton's all my lands divided as followeth beginning
 at a Black Gum and Maple at the run off the
 swamp he now live on running thence S¹/17th 12th
 poles crossing through the part of the plantation
 called the long field to a stake thence S¹/10th E¹
 out to the back line all below this line to be
 Enoch Newton and all above to be Isaac
 Newton, and should either of these my sons
 die without a lawful begotten heir then and
 in that case all the my land to fall rest
 and remain to the other son that do still
 survive. In the next place I give and bequeath
 unto my son Isaac Newton my Negro girl called
 Grace and that her first child that shall live
 to be our month old be my son Enoch Newton.
 And that her second child that shall live to be
 our month old be my daughter Esther Newton.
 And that her third child that shall live to be our
 month old be my daughter Ann Newton. I also
 give and bequeath to my daughter Esther Newton
 one feather bed and furniture. — and I also give
 and bequeath to my daughter Ann Newton one
 feather bed and furniture. I also give to my
 son Enoch Newton one mare colt and all the
 hogs and sheep to be equally divided between Enoch
 Newton and Isaac Newton — and that Enoch Newton
 have our third of my stock of Cattle and Isaac
 Newton have the other two thirds of the cattle
 and that the mare and young horse be my son
 Isaac Newton. And that all my house hold
 furniture be equally divided among my four
