May 5th 1861 - 1860

Proved in Court the 12th May 1861 by the oath of John Yarborough. Registered in the Registration office in Duplin County in Libⁿ 6. Folio 127 by me John Bird Reg^r In the name of God this fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty one I John Bird of Duplin County being very sick & weak in body but in perfect mind & memory thanks be given to God. Therefor calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it appertaineth for all men surely to die Do make and ordain this my last will and testament that to say principally and first of all I give & recommend my soul to God the ruler of the universe & let it go to him for my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Exes nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall have the same again my the mighty power of God almighty world estate hereunder it has pleased God to bestow me in this life. I give and devise to my son John Bird one hundred acres of land with the plantations wherein I now live and one negro boy name Peter one cow and yearling and one hen coll-name major to him and his heirs forever. Item I give to my well beloved son Michael Bird one negro girl name Tiffey and one cow and yearling and one rifle gun and a mare colt name munck to him and his heirs for ever Item I give to my well beloved daughter Elizabeth Beyond one mulatto girl name Clara one thin cows and

yearlings and to her and her heirs forever. Item I give to my well beloved daughter Delah Byrd the first child that any negro woman Pot shall have it shall live to be ten years old after which time all her cattle & colors to her and her heirs forever. Item I give to my well beloved Catherina Byrd one negro woman name Pot and all the remaining part of my estate that is not yet mentioned excepting my — one black sow and pigs and my other negroes that is not yet mentioned and those to be equally divided between my four children and I likewise constitute and make and ordain Michael King and Edward Bird my only and sole Execs of this my last will and testament and I do hereby entirely disannul revoke and disallow every other and former testament wills & legacies Bequeaths and executors by me at any time before this time named and bequeathed Reliving me and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament In witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and year above written signed sealed published and discharged by the said as his last will and testament in presence of us the subscribers
