I do hereby constitute and make this and this only my last will and Testament in manner and form following. And first I recommend my soul to god who gave it and my body to the dust from whence it came. To be secretly buried at the discretion of my Executors herein after named. Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Rebecca, the following negro. Ned Sharper, weldon, Edy, and her two children Leah and Ligett and their income & his and her their for ever to dispose of as she thinks proper also my boy horse. Slump the Saddle and old Cunningham and Riding Chair and harness five Cows and calves two good Cows four sows and twenty eight pigs, Household and Kitchen furniture all except two beds bedsteads and furniture. Sixty bushels of corn and all my fodder to her and her heirs forever free and clear. I also leave my said wife Rebecca, Bob and Bill the children of etc during her widow hood, also all the land and plantation and plantation tools during the non age of my son Lewis and at the time he becomes of the age of twenty one he said son Lewis is to take possession of the said plantation. and after paying all my just debts I give and bequeath to my son Lewis Stephen Herring all the remainder of my property of every description whatever that is not heretofore bequeathed to my said wife together with the part that is loaned her to him and her heirs forever and further I do by these presents authorise my Executor if they think proper to sell Moses and put the money at interest of all my son Lewis Estate that shall or may be by them sold until he arrives at full age. And I do by these presents make and constitute my Trusty and loving friends

David Wright and David Hooks my Executors to this my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 05th day of January 1819. Signed, sealed and delivered in presence of Wilson Hodges B. Bowden.

I Martin Hauchey of the County of Duplin being sick of Body but of perfect memory thanks be to god therefore and calling to mind the mortality of body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament. That is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul to god who gave it and my body I command to the earth to be buried in Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter to be named. Not doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of god and as touching what worldly estate I doth please god to bless me with in this life I give demise and dispose of the same in manner & form following first I give and bequeath to Sarah my Beloved wife, I give my house and plantation her life time or widowhood like wise all my hogs and cattle and house hold furniture plantation tools and my mare all for her use her life time or widowhood to raise my small children on to my son W^m Hauchey I give one hundred acres of land above Hines Ford on both sides of

Island Creek and to my wife 2 leave over hundred acres of Land where she wishes to have it on my Lands her lifetime or widowhood and to my youngest son at his decease. And the rest of my lands to be divided amongst them³ of my children and what household and plantation furniture horses hinds cattle and hogs are left at my wife decease to be equally divided among all my children. My notes bonds and accounts I leave to pay my debts, and last of all I make and ordain my two friends Daniel Murray and John Homan my whole and sole executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking and disannulling any will or wills by me before. And Next I give and bequeath unto Howel Hunter son of William Hunter fifty dollars \$50. Next I give and bequeath unto William Wright Hollingsworth fifty dollars \$50. Next I give and bequeath unto the boy now with me and bound to me Frederick Picket Jr. fifty dollars \$50. Next I give and bequeath unto John McCann Sr. fifty dollars \$50. Next I give and bequeath unto John Gaugh twenty dollars \$20. Next I give and bequeath unto Zekiah Grant. fifteen dollars \$15. Next I give and bequeath unto Benjamin Padget fifteen dollars \$15. Next I give and bequeath unto Margaret Manning Twenty five dollars \$25. If I give and bequeath unto Sally Luga Manning twenty five dollars \$25. Next as I have bestowed on some of my friends under age at present it is my will and intention therefore that if one or all or any part of the afore mentioned minors should die before they become the age of twenty one that then in that case the afore mentioned sum or sums herein given to them to be given to my four brothers to wit. Ned John, William & Nicol Hunter and and last by if then should be any surplus of my estate left after the afore mentioned division takes place and all my just debts is paid with every occurring expence that then and in that case the residue remaining to be divided between all mentioned in the above will who is now of the age of twenty one the division to be not exactly equal but in proportion to what is laid of to them in the afore
