Then was the within will proved in open Court in due form of Law by the oath of James Bizzell & at the same time James Bizzell the Executor named in the will qualified as such, ordered that letters issued. Test James Pearceall clerk. In the name of God Amen. I Mary Bizzell of the County of Duplin & State of North Carolina being far advanced in years & in a low state of bodily health but of sound disposing mind & memory thanks be to God for the same and knowing that it is appointed for all women once to die, have thought it would be best to settle my worldly estate in which it has pleased God to bless me with my will. And I do by these presents make and ordain this to be my last will and testament & revoking all others by me heretofore made and establishing this in manner & form following (to wit) And first I recommend my soul to God who giveth & my body to the dust from whence it came to be decently buried

Mary Bizzell at the discretion of my Executor here in after named & Secondly that all my just debts which very small & funeral charges, should be paid and the remainder of my 80 Estate to be divided as follows (To wit) I give to my daughter Elizabeth my Bay Archey horse to her and her heirs forever. I then give to my daughter Moley my sorrel colt to her & her heirs for ever. I also give to my two daughters Elizabeth and Moley all of the ballance of my property to be equally divided between them and their heirs for ever & lastly I constitute & appoint my son James Bizzell my Executor, with full power & authority to act as such. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal. This the 25th day of January 1829. Signed Sealed and acknowledged in the presence of Samuel Bizzell, James Bizzell
