Next I give unto my daughter Mary one bed + furniture now in her possession also I give unto the natural heirs of my daughter Mary body one negro girl Molley now in possession of my daughter Mary - Next I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth one negro girl name Hephry Jane at the decease of her grandmother decease also one bed and furniture when she departs the family Next I give and bequeath to my daughter Ester one negro girl name Charity also one bed and furniture when she departs the family. Next I give and bequeath to my daughter Anne or Honey one negro boy name Stephen Gilbert and also one bed and furniture when she departs the family - Next I give and bequeath to my daughter Catharine some one negro girl name Kitty Ann and also one bed + furniture when she departs the family - I furthermore give one negro boy name Jerry also one bed and furniture when he departs the family. Also I give and bequeath to my daughter Dismah one one bed and furniture when she departs the family and also one if any of the wenches now left in the life of the widow should have any child for him + if not then the above son Susan - comes to down - one of the above mentioned negroes left in the life of the widow to wit John and the balance to be divided as above mentioned. Last of all I nominate and appoint my friend David Sloan (Moss) my whole sole Exr + Vest him with full power + authority to this my last will + Testament to execute above mention in witness whereof I here unto set my hand and seal affixed this September 1st A.D. 1828 Signed Sealed + delivered in presence of us, John M.  Duplin County. In the name of God Amen the County with day of
 May 1781 I Peter Barbrie of the County & Province aforesaid being
 sick of body but of good and perfect memory thanks be to almighty
 God calling to remembrance the uncertainty of this transitory life
 and that all left must yeald unto death when it shall please
 God to call I do make and declare this my last will & testament
 in manner & form following first being persuaded and well witting
 for all my sins most humbly desire forgiveness for the same. I commend
 my soul unto the Almighty God my Saviour & redeemer in whom
 & by whose merits I trust and believe as sincerely to be saved and to
 have full remission and forgiveness of all my sins and to inherit the
 Kingdom of ~~God~~ Heaven and my body I commit to the earth to be
 decently buried at the discretion of my Exrs hereafter named and
 for the settling of my temporal estate & such good charities & debts
 as it has pleased God to bestow upon me I do order give & bestow
 and dispose the same in manner and form following that is to say
 in the first place I desire all my lawful and just debts be paid
 and to make provision for the same I dispose & bequeath to my well
 beloved wife Peggy my horse bridle & saddle. To my beloved son Allan
 I bequeath and give the plantation whereon I now live the north side
 of the road only my wife to have privilege of half the houses & half
 field. The field two life times and to my well beloved son John I
 bequeath and give the remainder of my land of the So Side of the
 road and allow to be at the expense to helping John to building a
 neat log house 20 and outstair and a outside chimney plank covered
 with short shingles To my well beloved daughter I bequeath & give one
 cow and calf and have the increase of all them and thence &
 for John Barbrie my son to let my son Allan have privilege of
 safe timber froms hells mill path eastward & fine wood. and the
 remainder of my estate enforce. and I desire it equally divided
 between my well beloved wife and children after they come to the age
 of twenty-one and I do here nominate constitute and appoint my
 friend Jesse Barbrie and my wife Peggy Barbrie full & sole
 Exrs & Eux of this my last will and testament hereby

revoking annulling & making void all other for wills & requests by me made & declared and declaring this to be my last will & testament in witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal

That was the annulment of William Beck proved in court by the oath of Willis Whitfield and James Wright two of the subscribing witnesses thereto And at the same time Alfred Beck and Thomas Wright Esqs named in said will came before the Court and qualified as Esqs according to last order of the Court issued accordingly Let Wm. Beck C. C. In the name of God amen I William Beck of Duplin County of North Carolina man that it is allotted for all men to die to therefore deem it prudent at this time being possessed of a sound and disposing mind and memory blessed be God for the same to express & declare in what manner my temporal estate shall be disposed of after my decease it is therefore my will and desire that the same be in the manner and form following that is to say First I give devise & bequeath to my loving wife Sarah Beck all that part and portion of plantation whereon I now live which is situated by my land being on the South Side of the Cape Fear River including my dwelling house and all the improvements belonging to the same and also all the improvements land lying to the South and west of the same plantation and dwelling house which is included in in the said plantation tract to have and to hold the same together with all the improvements appurtenances & appurtenances thereto belonging for and during her natural life Likewise I give and bequeath to my said wife the seven following negro slaves to wit Lewis Morris Abby Joanna bread Egebel and her child Edna also two head of horses say the young bay mare and young sorrel mare four cows and three calves Two head of sheep four sows & their pigs such as she may choose also one yoke of oxen and one cart my riding chair and harness two feather beds and furniture and so much of my house hold and kitchen furniture and family utensils as shall be deemed necessary by my Exrs here in the named for her use and convenience in keeping house and
