Item, I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Mary Remond two cows and calves and one feather bed and furniture and one man and Coli during her life viz. Item I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved son Robert Remond One Hundred Acres of Land Lying on the west side of Bearskin swamp joined Jacob Crumplers line, Also One cow and calf. Item I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved son Willis Remond one Cow and quailing also one pot two Basins four plates one Dish Ten spoons. I also leave William Butler and my whole and soul Executors of this my last will and Testament In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal the day and year above written Signed, Sealed and Acknowledged in presence of us. A short memorandum of a will Oct 10th 1784. Phillip Remond being in a very Low State of health and to the best of our understanding in the proper sense both here before God and us Ephraim and Adoni, faith Garrison do declare to the best of my knowledge and understanding the last will and testament as follows to my son Martine Remond one horse bridle and saddle and gun likewise twenty five head of cattle consisting of cows calves and other a young cattle, likewise two head of sheep two bottles two falling axes one bed and furniture two basins and seven plates) with all my stock of hogs more or less one hand mill one pair of Iron wheels one plow } To Elizabeth Remond my youngest daughter two cows and calves six new plates one set of tea cups and saucers one feather bed and furniture over frying pan one mug this I do acknowledge to be my Last and will and testament where unto I do in my write name set my hand and Seal. two Ephraim Garrison. Adonijah Garrison.
