Item 3rd I give to my daughter Sarah Boyet and her children the negro man Bob him to be sold and the money equally divided between her and her children. Item 4th I give to my son Edward Jones one dollar. Also the balance of my property not all ready disposed of after paying my just debts out of the same then to be sold and equally divided between my wife Sarah Jones, Emma Jones, Chas Smith, Anthony Jones, Jonas Jones and Edward Jones to some Daywood and Marshall and my little son Fubush Jones and Nancy Jones. I do further constitute and appoint my son Edward Jones and Levi Scamson Executors to this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I do publish this my Last will and Testament, July the 30th day A^d. D^o. 1830. Signed Sealed and declared in the presence of us Thomas Hill Jr. James Guines.

I lend to my beloved wife Martha Jones all the residue of property during her natural life and after her death the same shall belong to my beloved friends James James Harper and Winiford Smith to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever belonging thereto. Further I do hereby nominate and appoint my trusty friends Wright Smith and William Whitfield Executors to this my last will and testament, hereby making null and void former wills and Testaments by me made and this only to be my last will and Testament hereby ratifying and confirming the same in witness I hereby and hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal the day and year first within written.  Signath to my wife Jane all my Property, except
 what I have given to others at her decease, after
 paying all my just debts and funeral expences.
 I hereby make and Ordain my worthy friends
 Abraham Mottin Sr and Jesse Mottin Executors of
 this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof
 the said Thomas Jamigan have to this my last will
 and Testament set my hand and seal the day and
