Fifthly I will and bequeath to my son in law Henry Allen, one part of my Land containing one hundred and forty ^{five} acres part of my survey I bot of John Cook and on the north side of indian branch including the plantation the said Henry Allen cleared the upper part of the said survey to him and his heirs for ever. Sixthly I will and bequeath to my son in law Jacob Wells one hundred and five acres of the lower part of the above mentioned survey. I bot of Cook joining Henry Allins and also one survey of fifty acres on both sides of Island Creek that I bot of Frederick Wells to him and his heirs for ever. Seventhly I will and ordain that one horse and two saddles and all my plantation tools of every kind to be equally divided amongst my three sons in law Hardy Parker, Henry Allen and Jacob Wells. Eighthly ^{twice} to my wife one loom and one Llay. Lastly I constitute and appoint my beloved wife Mary Bowzer Executrix and Timothy Teachey Executor of this my last will and testament revoking all other wills here to fore made by me in testimony here of. I have here unto set my hand this the 21st day of June 1790. Signed sealed published in the presence of us. At Timothy Teachey and Lewis Gil stop

I Samuel Boyt of the County of Duplin State of North Carolina being sick but of sound mind and perfect memory thanks be to God for the same calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that my body, and that it is appointed for all men once to die I there fore make this my last will and testament. First of all I recommend my soul to God that governs and

and my body to be buried in a christian like manner at the discretion of my Exrs which I shall here after mention also my just debts and funeral expenses to be paid of. Item I give to my beloved wife Therby Boyt during her natural life time or widow hood the maner plantation one mare saddle + bridle together with all the house hold furniture one calf + cow + heifer and at her death or marriage every thing there is which I leave to her to be equally divided between my two sons + my hope what is not wanting for my family use to be sold and the money equally divided between my two sons equal share and share alike Item I give and bequeath to my son John Boyt the maner plantation where on I now live with all the land belonging to it one mare one cow + yearling two years old. Also and seven silver dollars to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath to my son Amos Boyt a tract of land down ash branch below and joining the maner plantation, one cow + yearling one year sold mare seven silver dollars to him and his heirs for ever. Likewise I bear my beloved brother Mrs B. with my brother Arthur Boyt Exrs of this my last will and testament and revoking all other will or wills I acknowledge to be my last will and testament signed sealed subscribed delivered and published to be my last will and testament of presence of these witnesses This the fourteenth day of may Anno 1791 Thomas ^{his} Phillips ^{mark}
