It will be understood that I have given my daughter Martha Rubenokah and Elizabeth all that I intend for them. — Then I hereby constitute and appoint my friends Benjamin Fussell and Stephen Williams my Executors to this my last will and testament.  and no more. Item I give and bequeath unto my
 son James Guy all the land that lies joining to his land
 that he now holds all that shold now grow from the fork
 of the branch of Turkey on the south & side of the same
 Running up said branch with the stream thereof unto
 James Beardsons Line to him and his heirs for ever &
 no more. Item I give and bequeath unto my son John
 Guy the Land that I now hold on the N^W side of Turkey
 Bounded by the same stream that Jo Guy is and in main
