In the name of God Amen

I Samuel Sloan of the province of North Carolina and
County of Mecklenburg, being sick and weak in body but of
a sound and perfect mind and memory, and being
to mind the mortality of the body knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die do constitute and
ordain this my last will and Testament. I name and
give following Principally and first of all I bequeath
the land and my body to the
said County to be buried at the discretion of my Executors
Nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection
I shall Recurr the same again by the almighty Power
of God. And as Touching my worldly Estate that God
has Blessed me withal in this life I do give

and dispose of in manner and form following. I promise
first I will that all my just debts and funeral Charges be paid
and discharged. Item I do give to my well Beloved wife Mildred
Sloan all my whole Estate during her life or widowhood and
after her death or marriage to be sold and one third of the
Money I bequeath to her, of all Except my lands and that I will
to be sold and all the Money to be Equally divided amongst my
Children and the Children's part to be let out or Interest
till they are of age to receive it.

Item I do appoint my well Beloved wife Mildred Sloan and my
brother John Charles Sloan Executors to this my last will
and Testament, and I do hereby empower my above said
Executors to make sale of my part or parts of the estate on
any time when they shall think proper and I do Revoc-
ably and make vain all other and former Will or Wills
heretofore by me made allowing and acknowledging this and no
other be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and fixed my Seal this 23rd day of
November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and sixty seven
