First I commit my body to the dust and my soul to the God who gave it. Item 1st I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah Jones one year's provisions. Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my son Jones Jones the young horse named Shakespeare. Item 3rd I give to my daughter Sarah Boyet and her children the negro man Bob him to be sold and the money equally divided between her and her children. Item 4th I give to my son Edward Jones one dollar. Also the balance of my property not all ready disposed of after paying my just debts out of the same shall to be sold and equally divided between my wife Sarah Jones, Emma Jones, Edna Smith, Anthony Jones, Jonas Jones and Edward Jones too sons Daywood and Marshall and my little sons Frederick Jones and Nancy Jones. I do further constitute and appoint my son Edward Jones and Levi Semison Executors to this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I do publish this my Last will and Testament. July the 30th day A^d. D^{om}. 1830. Signed Sealed and declared in the presence of us. Thomas Hill Jr. James Grimes.

April the 11th day. In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight. In the name of God Amen, I Robert Jones of Duplin County and state of North Carolina being of sound and perfect sense, mind and memory, calling to mind that it is ordained for all men to die. Do make and ordain this my last will and testament. Recommending my soul unto the hands of my Redeemer and my body to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my friends or Executors hereafter named &c. First that my just debts being first paid I give and dispose of my Estate where with it hath been pleased God to bless me with in the manner and form following viz:- I give and bequeath to my beloved friend James Harper one negro boy David to him and his heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to my beloved friend Winiford Smith twenty five dollars to her and to her heirs forever. I lend to my beloved wife Martha Jones all the Residue of property during her natural life and after her death the same shall belong to my beloved friends James James Harper and Winiford Smith to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever belonging thereto. Further I do hereby nominate and appoint my trusty friends Wright Smith and William Whitfield Executors to this my last will and Testament, hereby making null and void former wills and Testaments by me made and this only to be my last will and Testament hereby ratifying and confirming the same in witness I hereby and hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal the day and year first within written. Signed Sealed and published and declared by me, Robert Jones to be my Last will and Testament. In presence of Witnesses John Brown.
